1. Device Overview

The WIKO T20 is a feature-rich smartphone designed for daily use, offering a large display, powerful performance, and long-lasting battery life. Familiarize yourself with the device's physical components.

2. Setup

Follow these steps to set up your WIKO T20 Smartphone for the first time.

2.1. Inserting SIM Cards and SD Card

The WIKO T20 supports dual SIM cards and a separate slot for a microSD card to expand storage. Locate the SIM tray on the side of the device.

- 1. Power off the device before inserting or removing SIM/SD cards.
- 2. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the SIM tray.

- 3. Carefully place your Nano-SIM cards and microSD card into their respective slots on the tray. Ensure they are correctly oriented.
- 4. Gently push the SIM tray back into the device until it is flush.

2.2. Initial Charging

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the device.

- Connect the USB Type-C cable to the charging port at the bottom of the phone.
- Connect the other end of the cable to the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.
- The battery indicator on the screen will show charging progress. A full charge for the 5000 mAh battery may take several hours.

2.3. Powering On and Initial Configuration

Press and hold the Power button until the WIKO logo appears. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial

setup, including:

- · Language selection.
- Connecting to a Wi-Fi network.
- Signing in with your Google account.
- Setting up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password, or fingerprint).

3. Operating Your Device

This section covers the basic operation and key features of your WIKO T20 Smartphone.

3.1. Display and Navigation

The WIKO T20 features a 6.56-inch HD+ display with a 60Hz refresh rate for smooth visuals.

- Touch Gestures: Tap to select, swipe to scroll, pinch to zoom.

- Notification Panel: Swipe down from the top of the screen to access notifications and quick settings.

3.4. Storage Management

The device comes with 128GB of internal storage, expandable via microSD card.

- Check Storage: Go to Settings > Storage to view used and available space.
- Free Up Space: Delete unnecessary files, clear app caches, or move media to an SD card.

3.5. Security Features

4. Maintenance

4.1. Cleaning the Device

4.2. Software Updates

- Go to Settings > System > System update to check for available updates.
- Ensure your device has sufficient battery and a stable internet connection before starting an update.

4.3. Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures, as they can degrade battery life.
- · Do not let the battery drain completely frequently.
- Use the original charger and cable for optimal charging.

5. Troubleshooting

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter with your WIKO T20 Smartphone.

5.1. Device Not Turning On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on.
- Press and hold the Power button for at least 10-15 seconds to force a restart.

5.2. Screen Issues (Unresponsive, Frozen)

- Force restart the device by holding the Power button.
- If the screen is unresponsive, try cleaning it with a soft cloth.

5.3. Battery Draining Quickly

- Check battery usage in Settings > Battery to identify power-consuming apps.
- Reduce screen brightness and disable unnecessary features like Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, or GPS when not in use.
- Close background applications.

5.4. Apps Crashing or Not Responding

- Clear the cache and data of the problematic app in Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage
- Update the app to its latest version from the Google Play Store.
- If the issue persists, uninstall and reinstall the app.

5.5. Factory Reset

If other troubleshooting steps fail, a factory reset can resolve persistent software issues. Warning: This will erase all

data on your device. Back up important data before proceeding.

- Go to Settings > System > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset)
- Confirm your decision and follow the on-screen instructions.


