## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe installation, operation, and maintenance of your new shower system. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and retain them for future reference. This thermostatic shower set is designed for built-in installation, offering a sleek and modern aesthetic. It features a main rain shower head, a hand shower, and a thermostatic mixer for precise temperature control.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Professional Installation Recommended:** Installation should be performed by a qualified plumber in accordance with local plumbing and building codes.
- **Water Supply:** Ensure the main water supply is turned off before beginning any installation work.
- **Water Pressure:** Verify that your home's water pressure is within the recommended range for optimal performance.
- **Hot Water Safety:** The thermostatic mixer is designed to prevent scalding, but always test water temperature before use, especially for children or individuals with sensitive skin.
- **Component Handling:** Handle all components with care to avoid damage to finishes or internal mechanisms.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check that all components are present and undamaged before installation:

- Thermostatic Mixer Valve (Built-in)
- Control Plate and Handles

- Rain Shower Head
- Shower Arm (Wall-mounted)
- Hand Shower
- Shower Hose
- Wall Outlet / Hand Shower Holder
- Mounting Hardware (screws, anchors, seals)

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

This section provides general guidelines for the installation of your built-in shower set. Due to the complexity of built-in plumbing, professional installation is strongly recommended.

### 1. Pre-Installation Checks

1. **Inspect Components:** Ensure all parts are present and undamaged.
2. **Water Supply:** Turn off the main water supply to the bathroom.
3. **Wall Preparation:** Prepare the wall cavity according to the dimensions provided in the technical diagram for the built-in mixer and piping.
4. **Water Connections:** Identify hot and cold water lines. Hot water is typically on the left, cold on the right.

### 2. Mixer Valve Installation

1. Mount the built-in thermostatic mixer valve securely within the wall cavity, ensuring it is level and at the correct depth relative to the finished wall surface.
2. Connect the hot and cold water supply lines to the designated inlets on the mixer valve.
3. Connect the outlets from the mixer valve to the pipes leading to the rain shower head and the hand shower wall outlet.
4. Perform a leak test before closing the wall.

## **MAINTENANCE**

---

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your IMEX shower set.

## Cleaning the Finish

- Clean the matte black finish regularly with a soft cloth and mild soap and water.
- **DO NOT** use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or chemical cleaners containing ammonia, bleach, or alcohol, as these can damage the finish.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots.

## Shower Head Maintenance

- The nozzles on the rain shower head and hand shower are designed to be easy to clean. Periodically rub the silicone nozzles to dislodge any limescale buildup.
- For more stubborn limescale, a solution of white vinegar and water can be used. Soak the shower head (if removable) or apply the solution with a cloth, then rinse thoroughly.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your shower set, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Water Flow or Low Pressure:**
  - Check if the main water supply is fully open.
  - Inspect for blockages in the shower head nozzles or hose.
  - Verify that the mixer valve is fully open.
- **Inconsistent Water Temperature:**
  - Ensure hot and cold water supplies are connected correctly.
  - Check the thermostatic cartridge for limescale buildup (may require professional cleaning or replacement).
  - Verify stable hot water supply from your water heater.
- **Leaks from Connections:**
  - Turn off the water supply immediately.
  - Check all connections for proper tightening and ensure seals/washers are correctly seated and not damaged.
