INTRODUCTION

The Sudio E3 Wireless Earbuds are designed to provide a superior audio experience with advanced features such as Hybrid Active Noise Cancellation (ANC), Bluetooth 5.3 connectivity, and extended playtime. These earbuds are built for comfort, clarity, and durability, making them suitable for various daily activities.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening your Sudio E3 package, you should find the following components:

- Sudio E3 Earbuds (Left and Right)
- Wireless Charging Case

- USB-C Charging Cable
- Eartips (4 sizes: XS, S, M, L)
- User Manual (this document)

SETUP

1. Initial Charging

Before first use, ensure your Sudio E3 earbuds and charging case are fully charged. Place the earbuds into the charging case and close the lid. Connect the USB-C cable to the charging port on the case and to a power source. The indicator light on the case will show charging status. The case also supports wireless charging.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Open the charging case with the earbuds inside. The earbuds will automatically enter pairing mode, indicated by a flashing light on the case.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), go to the Bluetooth settings.
3. Select "Sudio E3" from the list of available devices.
4. Once connected, the indicator light on the case will stop flashing or change color (refer to specific light indicators in the manual for details).

3. Fitting the Earbuds

For optimal sound quality and comfort, select the correct size of eartips. The Sudio E3 comes with four sizes (XS, S, M, L). Experiment to find the best fit that creates a good seal in your ear canal.

- Gently insert the earbud into your ear canal.
- Twist slightly to ensure a secure and comfortable fit.
- A proper fit enhances noise cancellation and bass response.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Open the charging case, and the earbuds will automatically power on and connect to the last paired device.
- **Power Off:** Place the earbuds back into the charging case and close the lid. They will automatically power off and begin charging.

Touch Controls

The Sudio E3 earbuds feature intuitive touch controls on each earbud. The specific functions are:

Action	Control
Play/Pause Music	Single tap on either earbud
Next Track	Double tap on the right earbud

Action	Control
Previous Track	Double tap on the left earbud
Answer/End Call	Single tap on either earbud
Reject Call	Press and hold on either earbud for 2 seconds
Activate Voice Assistant	Triple tap on the left earbud
Toggle ANC/Transparency Mode	Press and hold on the right earbud for 2 seconds

Multi-point Bluetooth Connection

The Sudio E3 supports multi-point connection, allowing you to connect to two devices simultaneously (e.g., a smartphone and a laptop). To use this feature:

1. Pair the earbuds with your first device as described in the "Bluetooth Pairing" section.
2. Disconnect the earbuds from the first device's Bluetooth settings (do not unpair).
3. Place the earbuds back in the case, close, and reopen to re-enter pairing mode.
4. Pair the earbuds with your second device.
5. Reconnect the earbuds to the first device from its Bluetooth settings. The earbuds should now be connected to both devices.

Audio will automatically switch between devices based on which one is actively playing sound or receiving a call.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Regularly clean the earbuds and charging case with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Remove eartips and clean them with mild soap and water. Ensure they are completely dry before reattaching.
- Use a cotton swab to gently clean the speaker mesh and charging contacts. Avoid using sharp objects.

Storage

Always store the earbuds in their charging case when not in use to protect them from dust, damage, and to keep them charged.

Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the earbuds and case to extreme temperatures (hot or cold).
- Do not fully deplete the battery frequently. Charge them regularly to prolong battery life.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution

Problem	Possible Solution
Earbuds not pairing/connecting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure earbuds are charged.◦ Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device.◦ Forget "Sudio E3" in your device's Bluetooth settings and re-pair.◦ Place earbuds in case, close lid, wait 10 seconds, then reopen.
Only one earbud playing sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure both earbuds are charged.◦ Place both earbuds back in the case, close the lid, and then reopen.◦ Clean the charging contacts on both earbuds and inside the case.
Low volume or poor sound quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Adjust volume on your device and earbuds.◦ Ensure eartips provide a proper seal. Try different sizes.◦ Clean speaker mesh for any debris.
Charging issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Check USB-C cable and power adapter.◦ Ensure charging contacts on earbuds and case are clean.◦ Try a different charging method (wired vs. wireless).
