IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please adhere to the following safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage to the product:

- Always follow the assembly instructions carefully to ensure the cabinet is stable and secure.
- Do not overload the cabinet. The maximum weight capacity for this unit is **450 lbs**. Distribute weight evenly across shelves and compartments.
- Keep the area around the cabinet clear to prevent tripping hazards.
- Always unplug any electrical appliances placed within or near the cabinet before cleaning or performing maintenance.
- Utilize the included anti-tip hardware to secure the cabinet to a wall, especially in homes with children or pets, to prevent accidental tipping.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, please verify that all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the detailed parts list provided in your separate assembly manual. Typical contents include:

- Cabinet Panels (Side panels, Top panel, Bottom panel, Back panels, Shelf panels, Door panels, Drawer front panels)
- Hardware Pack (Screws, Dowels, Cam locks, Hinges, Drawer slides, Handles, Anti-tip kit)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the HOSTACK Farmhouse Kitchen Pantry Cabinet requires careful attention to detail. While the process is designed to be frustration-free, it is recommended to have at least two people for assembly due to the size and weight of the components. Please follow the numbered steps in the dedicated assembly manual included in your package.

Pre-Assembly Checklist:

- Clear a spacious, clean, and level area for assembly.
- Lay out all components and hardware, organizing them by their corresponding labels.
- Gather necessary tools (e.g., Phillips head screwdriver, hammer). A power drill with appropriate bits can speed up the process but use caution to avoid overtightening.

General Assembly Steps (Refer to your specific manual for detailed steps):

1. **Base Assembly:** Begin by assembling the base frame of the cabinet.
2. **Side Panel Attachment:** Secure the side panels to the base.
3. **Shelf and Divider Installation:** Install fixed and adjustable shelves and internal dividers as indicated.
4. **Drawer Assembly:** Assemble the two easy-glide drawers and install their respective slides.
5. **Door Installation:** Attach the barn doors using the provided hinges. Adjust hinges for proper alignment.
6. **Back Panel Attachment:** Secure the back panels to the cabinet frame. Ensure they are flush and square.
7. **Handle Installation:** Attach handles to the drawers and doors.
8. **Anti-Tip Kit Installation:** Crucially, install the anti-tip hardware to secure the cabinet to a wall. This step is vital for safety.

OPERATING THE CABINET

The HOSTACK pantry cabinet is designed for versatile storage and display. Here's how to best utilize its features:

- **Drawers:** The two easy-glide drawers are ideal for storing smaller items, utensils, or linens. Pull them out smoothly to access contents.
- **Door Cabinets:** The three door cabinets (two upper, one lower) conceal adjustable shelves, perfect for pantry items, dishes, or larger appliances. Open the barn doors by pulling the handles.
- **Open Compartments:** The two open compartments are suitable for frequently used items, decorative pieces, or small appliances like a microwave or toaster. The larger open compartment is specifically designed to accommodate a microwave.
- **Cable Management:** Note the cable management holes in the open compartments, useful for routing power cords for appliances.

- **Top Fence:** The impressive 76-inch tall body includes a fence above the upper cabinet, providing extra storage space for plants, picnic baskets, or other items.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your HOSTACK cabinet, follow these care instructions:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For tougher spots, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for wood or furniture. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive pads, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining or warping of the wood.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the cabinet with a dry, soft cloth to prevent buildup.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain stability.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, which can cause fading or discoloration over time.
- **Heat and Moisture:** Keep the cabinet away from direct heat sources and areas of high humidity to prevent warping or damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Cabinet Feels Wobbly:**
 - Ensure all cam locks and screws are fully tightened.
 - Verify that the cabinet is placed on a level surface. Use shims if necessary to stabilize.
 - Confirm that the back panels are securely attached and square, as they contribute to the cabinet's rigidity.
 - Ensure the anti-tip kit is properly installed and secured to the wall.
- **Drawers or Doors Do Not Align/Close Properly:**
 - Check that the drawer slides are installed correctly and are not bent.
 - Adjust the hinges on the doors. Most hinges allow for minor adjustments (up/down, left/right, in/out) using a screwdriver.
 - Ensure the cabinet frame is square and level.
- **Parts Scuffed or Damaged During Assembly:**
 - While care is taken in packaging, minor scuffs can occur. For significant damage, contact customer support for replacement parts.
 - When assembling, place components on a soft, clean surface (e.g., a blanket or cardboard) to prevent scratching.
- **Difficulty with Assembly Steps:**
 - Double-check the numbered parts against the assembly manual's diagrams.
 - Do not force parts together. If a piece doesn't fit, re-examine the instructions for correct orientation.
 - Consider seeking assistance from another person, as some steps are easier with two people.
