SETUP

Follow these steps for the initial setup of your Dolphin Explorer E40:

1. **Unpack and Assemble:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the filter cartridges are properly installed in the cleaner.
2. **Position the Power Supply:** Place the power supply unit at least 12 feet (3.6 meters) from the edge of the pool. Ensure it is in a shaded area and not exposed to direct sunlight or standing water.
3. **Connect the Cleaner:** Connect the floating cable from the Dolphin Explorer E40 to the power supply unit. Ensure the connection is secure.
4. **Plug into Power:** Plug the power supply unit into a grounded electrical outlet.
5. **Place in Pool:** Gently lower the Dolphin Explorer E40 into the pool. Allow it to sink to the bottom, releasing any trapped air bubbles. Ensure the floating cable is not tangled.





OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Dolphin Explorer E40 offers convenient operation through its Wi-Fi connectivity and intuitive controls.

Initial Start-Up

1. After placing the cleaner in the pool and connecting the power supply, press the ON/OFF button on the power supply unit. The cleaner will begin its cleaning cycle.
2. The Explorer E40 is designed for precise movement and agile steering, navigating around obstacles with its Dual Drive system.

Wi-Fi Connectivity and App Control

The Dolphin Explorer E40 can be controlled and scheduled from anywhere using the MyDolphin Plus mobile app.

1. Download the MyDolphin Plus app from your device's app store.
2. Follow the in-app instructions to connect your Explorer E40 to your home Wi-Fi network.
3. Once connected, you can schedule weekly cleanings, select different cleaning modes, manually drive the robot, and receive full filter indicators directly on your smartphone.

Filter Cleaning

The Explorer E40 features an easy-access top-load filter system for convenient cleaning.

1. After each cleaning cycle, or when the full filter indicator is active, remove the cleaner from the pool.
2. Open the top cover of the cleaner.
3. Pull out the filter basket.
4. Rinse the filter basket thoroughly with a garden hose to remove all debris.
5. Reinsert the clean filter basket and close the top cover.

General Care

- Store the cleaner in a shaded area when not in use.
- Avoid leaving the cleaner in the pool for extended periods when not operating.
- Periodically check the brushes and tracks for wear and tear.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Dolphin Explorer E40, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cleaner not moving or starting.	No power, tangled cable, debris in motor.	Check power supply connection, untangle cable, inspect for debris in brushes/impeller.
Poor cleaning performance.	Clogged filter, worn brushes, incorrect cleaning mode.	Clean filter basket, check brush condition, select appropriate cleaning mode via app.
Cleaner not climbing walls.	Air in cleaner, dirty filter, water chemistry imbalance.	Ensure all air is released, clean filter, check pool water chemistry (pH, alkalinity).
Cleaner getting stuck.	Obstacles in pool, cable tangling.	Remove large obstacles, ensure cable is spread out before operation.
