## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your KOMFOTT Bunk Bed with Trundle, Model 10655-HU-KT. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial for preventing injury and ensuring the longevity of your bunk bed.

- **Warning:** Follow all assembly instructions carefully and completely.
- **Weight Limits:** Do not exceed the specified weight limits for each bunk. Refer to the 'Product Specifications' section for details.
- **Age Restriction:** The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.

- **Guardrails:** Always use guardrails on both sides of the upper bunk to prevent falls.
- **Mattress Size:** Use only mattresses of the specified size to ensure proper fit and safety.
- **Ladder Safety:** Ensure the ladder is securely attached before use. Always use the ladder for access to the upper bunk.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check and tighten all connections and hardware.

### 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly of the KOMFOTT Bunk Bed with Trundle requires careful attention to detail. It is recommended that two adults perform the assembly.

#### 3.1. Before You Begin

- **Clear Area:** Choose a spacious, clear area for assembly to avoid damage to components or flooring.

4. **Assemble Trundle:** Assemble the trundle bed frame, ensuring the wheels are properly attached for smooth operation.
5. **Stack Bunks:** Carefully lift and place the upper bunk frame onto the lower bunk frame, aligning all connection points. Secure with the provided hardware.
6. **Attach Ladder and Guardrails:** Install the ladder and all safety guardrails to the upper bunk, ensuring they are firmly fastened.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once fully assembled, re-check and tighten all bolts and screws to ensure maximum stability. Do not overtighten.

### 4. OPERATING GUIDELINES

---

Proper use of your bunk bed ensures safety and comfort.

- **Mattress Placement:** Place the appropriate size mattress on each bunk and the trundle. Ensure mattresses do not exceed the maximum thickness recommended for the upper bunk to maintain guardrail effectiveness.
- **Trundle Bed Use:** The trundle bed can be easily pulled out for an additional sleeping space or pushed back

in for compact storage. Ensure the area around the trundle is clear before extending or retracting.

- **Ladder Access:** Always use the provided ladder to access the upper bunk. Do not climb on the side rails or other parts of the bed structure.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly on each bunk. Avoid concentrating weight in one small area.

## 5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

Regular care will help maintain the appearance and structural integrity of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bed frame with a damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to ensure the bed remains stable and secure.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** Protect the wood from prolonged exposure to moisture or extreme temperature changes.
- **Moving the Bed:** When moving the bed, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent damage to the frame and floor.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable	Loose hardware connections.	Inspect all bolts and screws. Tighten any that are loose. Ensure all parts are correctly aligned.
Squeaking noises	Loose connections or friction between wood parts.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to contact points if necessary.
Trundle bed does not slide smoothly	Obstruction, dirty wheels, or misaligned frame.	Check for objects obstructing the path. Clean wheels. Ensure the trundle frame is assembled correctly and not warped.
Ladder feels insecure	Ladder not properly attached or hardware loose.	Verify the ladder hooks or attachment points are fully engaged and all securing hardware is tightened.
