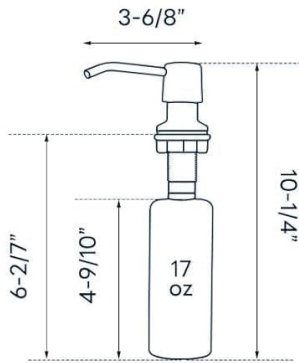

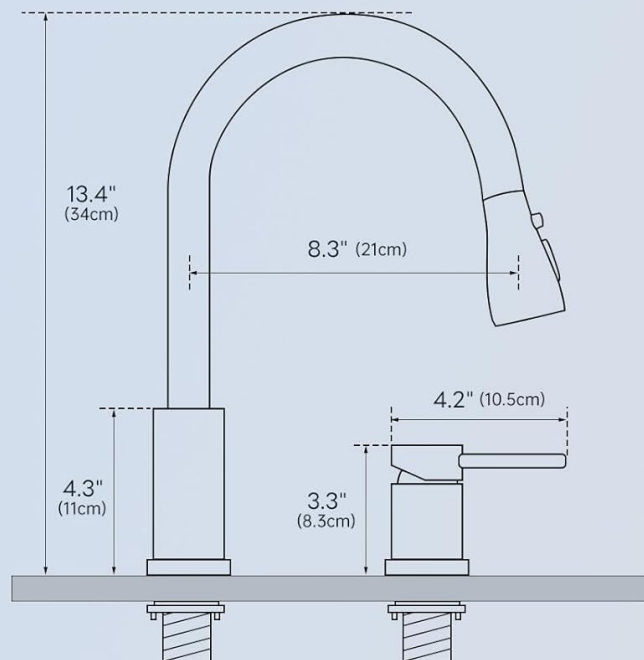

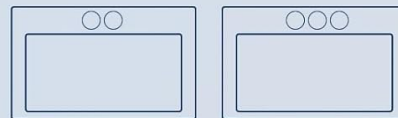


Image: Detailed diagram showing the dimensions of the faucet and soap dispenser, along with mounting hole requirements for 2 or 3-hole sinks.

5. INSTALLATION

5.1 Pre-Installation

- Ensure your sink has either 2 or 3 holes for proper installation.
- Clear the area under the sink and ensure easy access to water supply lines.
- Gather necessary tools: adjustable wrench, screwdriver, plumber's putty or silicone sealant, flashlight.

5.2 Installation Steps

1. **Mount the Faucet:** Insert the main faucet body and handle into the designated holes on your sink or countertop. Secure from underneath with the provided mounting hardware.
2. **Connect Water Supply Lines:** Attach the hot and cold water supply lines to your existing water valves. Ensure a tight, leak-free connection. The faucet features quick-connect fittings for ease of installation.
3. **Install Soap Dispenser:** Insert the soap dispenser pump into its hole and secure the bottle from underneath.

4. **Attach Gravity Ball:** Clip the gravity ball weight onto the pull-down hose under the sink. This ensures the sprayer retracts smoothly.
5. **Test for Leaks:** Turn on the main water supply and check all connections for any leaks. Operate the faucet to ensure proper water flow and temperature control.

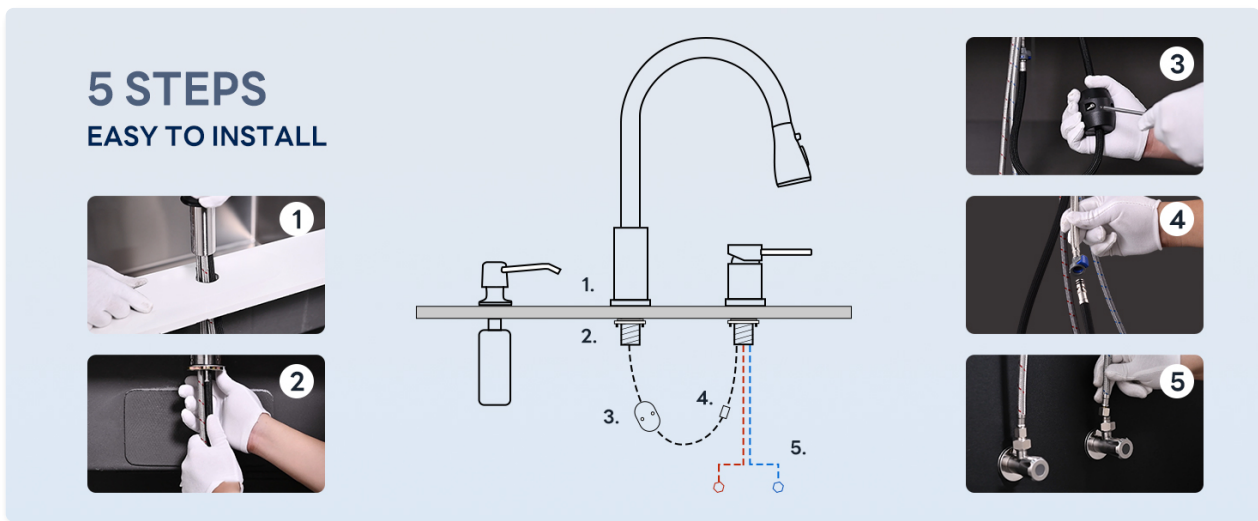


Image: A visual guide illustrating the five easy steps for installing the APPASO kitchen faucet, from mounting to connecting water lines and the soap dispenser.

6. OPERATION

6.1 Water Flow and Temperature Control

The single handle controls both water flow and temperature. Move the handle up to increase water flow and down to decrease it. Rotate the handle left for hot water and right for cold water.

6.2 Pull-Down Sprayer with 3 Modes

The pull-down sprayer offers three distinct spray modes for various tasks:

- **Stream Mode:** Provides a gentle, aerated flow for fast filling of pots and pans, minimizing splashing.
- **Spray Mode:** Delivers a powerful spray for quick rinsing of dishes and produce.
- **Dual Broom Mode:** A strong, concentrated stream designed for effortless removal of stubborn dirt and food residue.

To switch between modes, press the button on the sprayer head. The 20-inch long hose and 360° free rotation allow for extended reach and flexibility.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning the Faucet

To maintain the brushed nickel finish, clean the faucet regularly with a soft cloth and mild soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.

7.2 Cleaning the Aerator

If water flow becomes restricted or irregular, the aerator may need cleaning. Use the provided blue key to carefully remove the aerator from the sprayer head. Rinse any debris from the aerator screen under running water. Reinstall the aerator securely.

For speedy cleaning, use your fingertips.

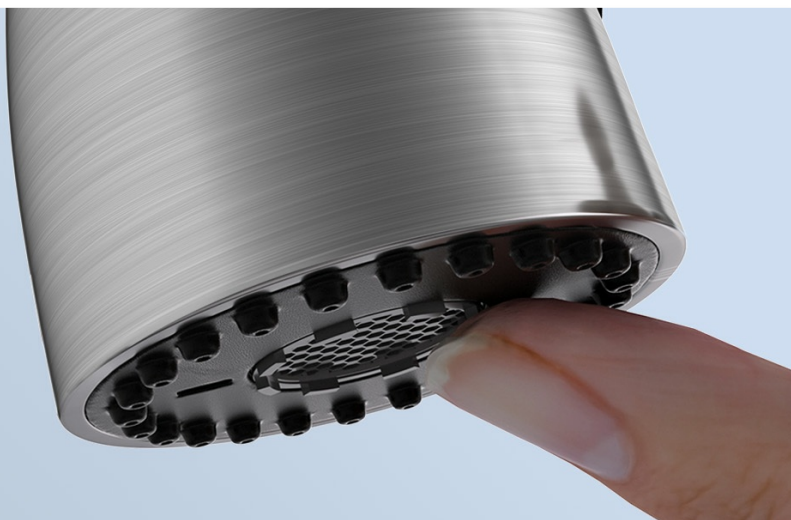


Image: A hand demonstrating the removal of the aerator from the faucet head using the blue key for easy cleaning.







8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Flow	Clogged aerator; partially closed shut-off valve; kinked supply line.	Clean aerator (see Section 7.2); ensure shut-off valves are fully open; check supply lines for kinks.
Leaks from Faucet Base	Loose mounting nut; worn gasket.	Tighten mounting nut; replace gasket if damaged.
Leaks from Sprayer Head	Loose connection; damaged O-ring.	Ensure sprayer hose is tightly connected; inspect and replace O-rings if necessary.
Sprayer Does Not Retract	Gravity ball weight is misplaced or obstructed.	Adjust the position of the gravity ball weight on the hose; ensure no obstructions under the sink.
