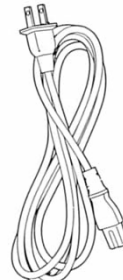

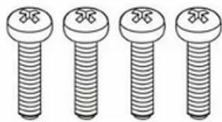

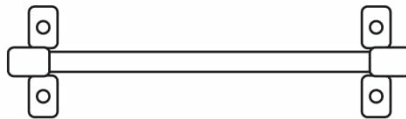

SETUP

1. Attaching the Stand or Wall Mounting

You can either place the TV on a flat surface using the provided base stands or mount it on a wall. Ensure the TV is placed on a stable surface or securely mounted to prevent accidental falls.

1. For Stand Installation:

- Carefully place the TV face down on a soft, clean surface to prevent screen damage.
- Align the base stands with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
- Secure each stand with the provided screws.

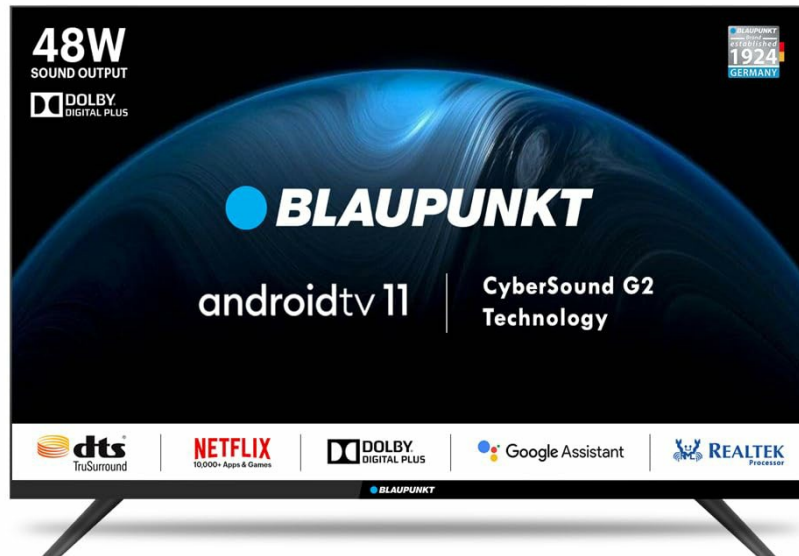

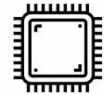

- **HDMI:** Connect gaming consoles, set-top boxes, or Blu-ray players to the 3 HDMI ports.

- **Power:** Connect the power cord to the TV and then to a power outlet.

3. Initial Power-On and Setup

After connecting all necessary cables, plug the TV into a power source and press the power button on the remote control or TV. Follow the on-screen instructions for initial setup, including language selection, network connection, and Google account login.

OPERATING THE TV

Remote Control Functions

The provided remote control allows you to navigate the TV's features. Insert the two AAA batteries into the remote, ensuring correct polarity.

- **Dedicated App Buttons:** Quick access to Netflix, Prime Video, YouTube, and Google Play.
- **Home Button:** Returns to the main Android TV home screen.
- **Back Button:** Returns to the previous screen or menu.

Display and Audio Settings

- **Sound Modes:** Select from various audio presets or customize equalizer settings. The TV features 48 Watts output with Dolby Digital Plus and DTS TruSurround for enhanced audio.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the TV

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen and cabinet.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive screen cleaner. Do not spray cleaner directly onto the screen.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive pads, or solvents as they can damage the TV's surface.

Software Updates

Your Android TV may receive software updates periodically. It is recommended to keep your TV connected to the internet to receive these updates, which can improve performance and add new features. You can usually check for updates in the TV's settings menu.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common solutions before contacting support.

Problem	Possible Solution
No Power	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working power outlet. Check if the power outlet is active.
No Picture, but Sound is Present	Check the input source. Ensure the connected device (e.g., set-top box) is powered on and functioning correctly. Try a different HDMI cable.
No Sound, but Picture is Present	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. Verify audio settings and external audio device connections if applicable.
Remote Control Not Responding	Replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
Cannot Connect to Wi-Fi	Ensure your Wi-Fi router is on and working. Re-enter the Wi-Fi password. Try restarting both the TV and the router.
Picture Quality Issues (e.g., Mura, light bleeding)	Minor light bleeding and Mura issues on certain grey scales are considered acceptable as per industry standards and are not covered under warranty as panel defects.
