# HLIPHA Metal Platform Bed Frame - Full 18 Inch

## Instruction Manual

### INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your HLIPHA Metal Platform Bed Frame (Full, 18 Inch). Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. This bed frame is designed to provide sturdy support for your mattress without the need for a box spring.

### SAFETY INFORMATION

---

**Be cautious during assembly to avoid injury from sharp edges or moving parts. Ensure no more than 1100 pounds is placed on the bed frame to maintain its stability and longevity.**

- Always assemble the bed frame on a soft, clean surface to prevent damage to the product or your floor.
- Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten fasteners.
- Do not allow children to climb or play on the bed frame during assembly or unsupervised.
- Distribute weight evenly across the bed frame. Avoid concentrating heavy loads in one area.

Before assembly, verify that all components and hardware are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Bed Frame Sections (Side Rails, Center Support, Legs)
- Support Slats

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly is designed to be straightforward. It is recommended to have two people for easier assembly, though it can be completed by one person.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface. Refer to the parts list in your included manual to identify each piece.
2. **Assemble Side Frames:** Connect the side rails to the leg sections using the provided bolts and tools. Ensure all connections are finger-tightened initially.
3. **Attach Center Support:** Secure the center support beam to the assembled side frames. This beam often connects in the middle and provides additional stability.
4. **Install Support Slats:** Place the metal support slats across the frame. These slats typically slot into

designated holes or rest on ledges along the side rails. Ensure they are evenly spaced and securely seated.

5. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, go back and securely tighten all bolts and screws using the provided tools. Do not overtighten.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

This bed frame is designed for use with a Full-size mattress (approximately 75" x 54").

- **Mattress Placement:** Carefully place your mattress directly onto the metal support slats. A box spring is not required for this platform bed frame.
- **Under-Bed Storage:** The 18-inch height of this frame provides significant clearance for under-bed storage. Utilize this space for bins, boxes, or other items to maximize room efficiency.
- **Noise Reduction:** The design incorporates features to minimize noise. If any squeaking occurs, refer to the troubleshooting section.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically inspect all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability and prevent noise.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Weight Limit:** Adhere to the maximum weight recommendation of 1100 pounds to ensure the longevity and safety of the bed frame.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Squeaking noises	Loose bolts or connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws on the frame. Ensure slats are properly seated.
Mattress slides on frame	Smooth surface of slats or mattress.	Consider placing a non-slip mat or rubber grippers between the mattress and the slats.
Frame feels unstable/wobbly	Incomplete assembly or loose connections.	Review assembly steps to ensure all parts are correctly installed and all fasteners are fully tightened.
