INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your RASTAR 99600 1/18 scale Porsche 911 GT2 RS Remote Control Car Building Kit. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly or operation to ensure proper function and safety.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components listed below are present in your package:

- Building kits (1 set, includes stickers)
- Remote controller (1)
- Instruction Manual (1)
- *Note: 5 AA Batteries are required (3 for the car, 2 for the controller) and are not included.*

INITIAL SETUP

Battery Installation

1. **For the Car:** Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the car chassis. Use a small screwdriver (not included) to open the battery cover. Insert 3 AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Securely close the battery cover.
2. **For the Remote Controller:** Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control. Open the cover and insert 2 AA batteries, observing correct polarity. Close the cover securely.

Tire Selection

The kit includes two sets of tires: one for drifting (smooth) and one for racing (treaded). Choose the appropriate set based on your desired driving experience. Refer to the assembly section for instructions on changing tires.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the step-by-step guide provided in the included manual to construct your Porsche 911 GT2 RS RC car. Ensure all parts are securely connected. Pay close attention to the illustrations for correct placement of components.

Key Assembly Points:

- **Chassis Assembly:** Begin by assembling the main chassis components as indicated in the manual.
- **Motor and Gearbox:** Carefully install the motor and connect it to the gearbox. Ensure all wiring is correctly routed and secured.
- **Wheel and Axle Installation:** Attach the axles and wheels. If changing tires, remove the small screw in the center of each wheel to swap them.
- **Body Panels and Details:** Affix the body panels, including doors, hood, and rear wing. Apply the provided stickers for authentic detailing.
- **Electronics Connection:** Connect the battery pack to the car's electronic components.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Pairing the Remote Control

1. Ensure fresh batteries are installed in both the car and the remote control.
2. Turn on the car using the ON/OFF switch located on its underside. The car's lights may blink, indicating it's searching for a signal.
3. Turn on the remote control. The indicator light on the remote should become solid, and the car's lights should stop blinking, confirming a successful connection.

Basic Controls

- **Forward/Reverse:** Use the trigger on the remote control. Pull to move forward, push to move backward.

- **Steering:** Use the steering wheel on the remote control to turn left or right.
- **Speed Modes:** The remote control may feature buttons to switch between low and high-speed modes. Low speed is recommended for indoor use and beginners.
- **Lights:** Some models may have a button on the remote to control the car's headlights and taillights.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the car's body. Avoid water or harsh chemicals.
- **Battery Care:** Remove batteries from both the car and remote control when not in use for extended periods to prevent leakage.
- **Storage:** Store the car and remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check for loose screws or damaged parts. Replace any broken components to maintain optimal performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car does not respond to remote.	Low or dead batteries in car/remote; improper pairing.	Replace batteries; re-pair car and remote (refer to "Pairing the Remote Control").
Car moves slowly or inconsistently.	Low batteries in car; obstruction in wheels/gears.	Replace car batteries; check and clear any obstructions.
Car pulls to one side.	Steering trim adjustment needed.	Adjust the steering trim dial on the underside of the car until it drives straight.

- Dispose of used batteries responsibly.





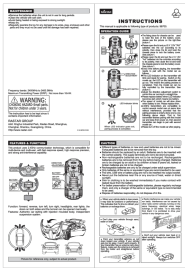
