1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: This product requires assembly. Always follow the assembly instructions carefully to ensure safe and proper installation. Do not exceed the weight capacity of 400 lbs per chair to prevent accidents. Keep away from children when assembling or disassembling the product.

- Ensure all components are present and undamaged before assembly.
- Assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Tighten all bolts and screws securely, but do not overtighten.
- Regularly check all fasteners to ensure they remain tight.
- Do not stand on the chairs or table.
- Place the set on a level surface to prevent wobbling or tipping.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this bistro set. Follow the steps below carefully. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

4.1. General Assembly Guidelines

1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a soft, flat surface to prevent damage.
2. Identify all parts and hardware using the provided parts list (not included in this digital manual, refer to physical manual).
3. Do not fully tighten screws until all parts are loosely assembled.
4. Once all parts are in place, gradually tighten all screws and bolts.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Using the Reclining Chairs

The chairs feature an adjustable reclining function for personalized comfort. To recline, gently push back on the backrest while seated. The chair will adjust to a comfortable ergonomic angle. To return to an upright position, lean forward slightly.

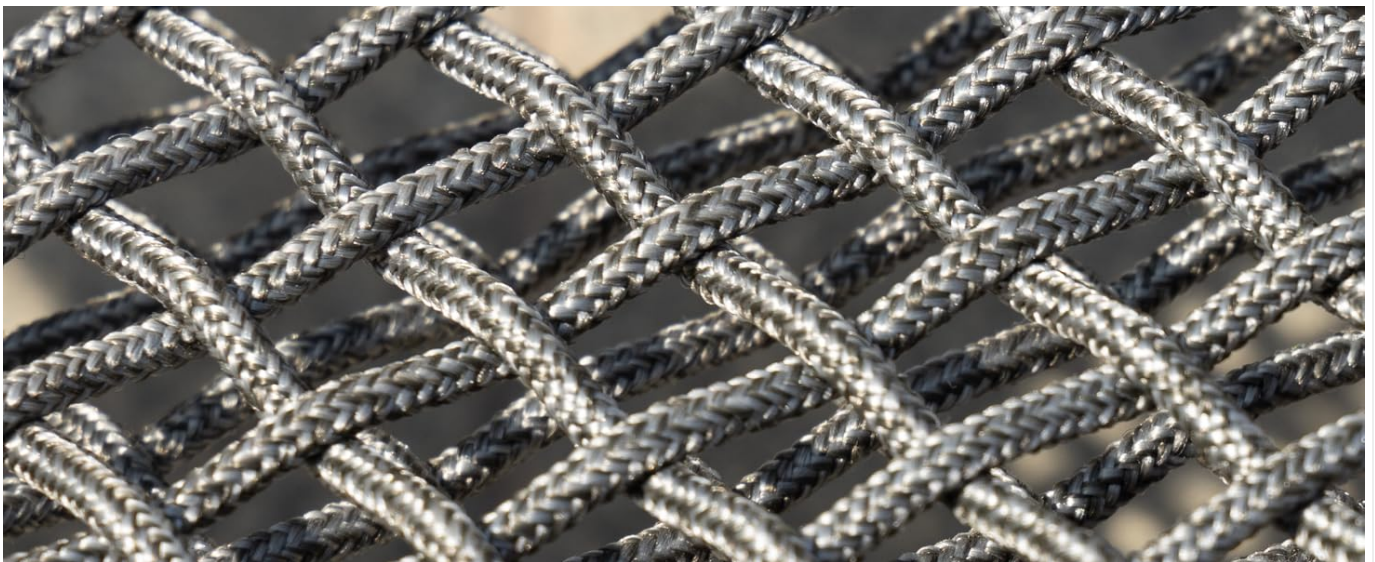

5.2. Weight Capacity

Each reclining chair is designed to support a maximum weight of 400 lbs. The end table has a static load capacity of 175 lbs. Do not exceed these limits to ensure safety and product longevity.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your IDZO Patio Bistro Set.

6.1. Cleaning

- Wipe the wood surfaces with a damp cloth to remove dust and dirt.
- For stubborn stains, use a mild soap solution and a soft brush, then rinse thoroughly and dry immediately.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the wood finish.

6.2. Wood Care

- Acacia wood is naturally durable but benefits from occasional oiling to maintain its rich color and protect against weathering. Use a wood-specific outdoor furniture oil.
- Store the furniture in a dry, covered area during harsh weather conditions or off-season to prevent damage.
- If left outdoors, consider using a protective cover.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

7.1. Chair Wobbles

- Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened. Loosen slightly, adjust the chair on a level surface, then retighten.
- Check if the floor surface is even. Uneven surfaces can cause wobbling.
- Verify that all parts were assembled correctly according to the instructions.

7.2. Difficulty Reclining

- Ensure there are no obstructions behind the chair.
- Check for any loose or overtightened fasteners that might impede the reclining mechanism.
