1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the operation and maintenance of your CAPOXO CP-PBV-32G-New Digital Voice Recorder. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to maximize its lifespan.

The CAPOXO CP-PBV-32G-New is a 32GB digital voice recorder designed for capturing audio with clarity. It features a long-lasting battery, voice-activated recording, and MP3 playback capabilities. Its compact design allows for discreet use in various environments.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

- **Recording Switch:** Slide to initiate or save recordings.
- **Headphone Plug:** For connecting earphones for audio playback.
- **USB/Charge Input:** For charging the device and connecting to a computer.

- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust playback volume.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the voice recorder. Connect the device to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator will show the charging status.

4.2 Connecting to a Computer

To transfer files or set the device's time, connect the recorder to your computer using the USB cable. The device will appear as a removable disk drive.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Recording

1. To start recording, slide the recording switch to the "ON" position. The device will begin recording automatically.
2. To save the recording and stop, slide the recording switch to the "OFF" position. The recording will be saved as an MP3 file.

5.2 Voice Activated Recording (AVR Mode)

The device supports Voice Activated Recording (AVR). Refer to the on-screen menu or specific instructions for activating and configuring this mode. In AVR mode, the recorder will automatically pause during silent periods to conserve storage space and battery life.

5.3 Playback

1. Connect the provided earphones to the headphone jack.
2. Use the menu button to navigate through saved recordings.
3. Press the play button (if available, or use the menu) to start playback.
4. Adjust volume using the volume buttons.

5.4 File Management

Recordings are saved as MP3 files. When connected to a computer, you can access, copy, move, or delete these files like

any other data on a USB drive. Files are typically organized by date for easy identification.

5.5 Magnetic Adsorption

The recorder features strong magnetic adsorption, allowing it to be easily attached to any metallic surface. This provides versatile placement options for recording.

Strong Magnetic Adsorption

Easily install on any object made with iron. You can use it in the office, on the refrigerator, under the chair or anywhere you want.

- Avoid dropping the device or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Regularly back up important recordings to a computer.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery.	Charge the device fully.
Cannot record.	Memory full; Recording switch not in "ON" position.	Delete old files to free up space; Ensure switch is in "ON" position.
Poor audio quality.	Device too far from sound source; High background noise.	Place the device closer to the sound source; Record in a quieter environment.
Device not recognized by computer.	Faulty USB cable; Driver issue; Incorrect connection.	Try a different USB cable or USB port; Restart computer; Ensure proper connection.




Image: The CAPOXO voice recorder placed next to a ruler, illustrating its physical dimensions of approximately 12 cm in length and 4.5 cm in width.

Power On/Off

Auto Power On
 Take the earbuds out from the charging case, they will turn on automatically.

Auto Power Off
 Put the earbuds back into the charging case, they will disconnect & turn off automatically.

Manually Power On
 If the earbuds are out of the charging case and power off, then press & hold the MFB button for 3s.

Manually Power Off
 In non-music mode or standby mode, press & hold either earbud for 5s, both earbuds will power off at the same time.



Bluetooth Connection

For the first use or not in use for long time, please fully charge both earbuds and the charging case.

Step 1: Take two earbuds out from charging case, they will automatically power on and enter pairing mode.
 At this time, led indicator of master earbud will flash Blue & Red light. At the same time, led indicator of slave earbud will indicator flash Blue 2 times every 5s.

Step 2: Go to the "Bluetooth" settings on your phone, search and connect "D8".
 Once connected, the red light of both earbuds gone off.



Note: If the earbuds are not connected to your device over 5 minutes, the earbuds will power off automatically.



For Second Time Use

If the earbuds have already connected with your device, and the Bluetooth setting of this device is on, in the second time using when you take out the earbuds from the charging case, they will connect automatically.

Pair with Other Device

All sports earbuds have memory function, they usually auto connect with the last paired device.

Thus, if you want to pair them with other device, you should first disconnect the earbuds from the last paired device, and forget the pairing record on the last device. Then try to connect it to a new device, it should work properly.

Music Mode (Only Left/Right Earbud is being used)

You can use one earbud alone, leave another earbud in the charging case.

When in Dual mode, put one earbud into the charging case.

Or only take one earbud out of the charging case, then search & connect "D8" on your device.





Factory Restore Settings

When should I reset?
 1) When one earbud plays music.
 2) Both earbuds can not work together.
 3) Once connection issues.

Follow Steps Below to Reset Earbuds

Step 1: Delete the pairing name "D8" on your phone and delete the earbuds from the settings of your device.

Step 2: Put the earbuds in the charging case, keep them in the case for 10 minutes.

Step 3: Press the MFB button for 3 seconds, then the earbud will flash Blue 2 times every 5s.

Step 4: Now, pick up the earbuds to turn them on, activate the pairing mode of your phone again and select "D8" to connect, it should work properly.

Step 5: Once the pairing is successful, put the earbuds back to the charging case and repeat the steps above.

Note: After resetting, the pairing record between the earbuds and all your devices will be cleared. In case there is any unsuccessful message on your device, please consider to delete the historical record of "D8" and try the pairing process again.



Earbuds Charging

To Charge Earbuds
 Insert the Earbuds into charging case properly, they will power on & get charged.

Flash during charging
 Turn on once fully charged.

Earbuds LED light Red light up means "being charged", Red light off means "fully charged".

Low Battery Alarm

When the battery level is less than 10% and the charge is lower than 10%, a prompt "Please charge" will be displayed, alarm goes on every 5 minutes and 5 times in total, and then the earbuds will power off as a result.

Tip: If the earbuds don't charge or even can't turn on, that may because there is a conductive dust or something else in the charging connector or charging pin.

Notes: The earbuds will stop this process by clearing its magnetic field when the earbuds and charging pin on the charging case with another earbuds.





Charging Case Charging

Type-C Charging
 There is a Type-C charging cable in the small black paper box inside the packing box. Please use the provided Type-C cable with a 5V/1A adapter/plug included to charge the charging case.

Wireless Charging
 Easy to charge your charging case without cables, just put the charging case on the wireless charging pad.

To Charge Your Phone

Fully charged charging case supports charging your mobile phone, connect it to your mobile phone with your charging cable.


