1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and effective use of your Retevis P62 IP68 Waterproof Dual Band Walkie Talkie. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device to ensure proper function and to prevent damage. The Retevis P62 is designed for reliable two-way communication in various environments, featuring robust construction and advanced functionalities.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Retevis P62 walkie talkie incorporates several features designed for reliable and efficient communication.

3.1. IP68 Waterproof and Dustproof Rating

The device is rated IP68, providing protection against dust ingress and immersion in water up to 1 meter for 2 hours. This allows for effective operation in challenging weather conditions such as heavy rain or dusty environments.

3.2. Durable Construction

Constructed with solid metal aluminum plates and high-quality ABS and PC materials, the P62 is designed to be shock-resistant, ensuring prolonged use without concern for sudden drops or impacts.

3.3. Easy Pairing Function

The device supports easy pairing with various two-way radios, enabling quick communication with team members using different radio models.

Seek and pair with various two way radios through shortcut key

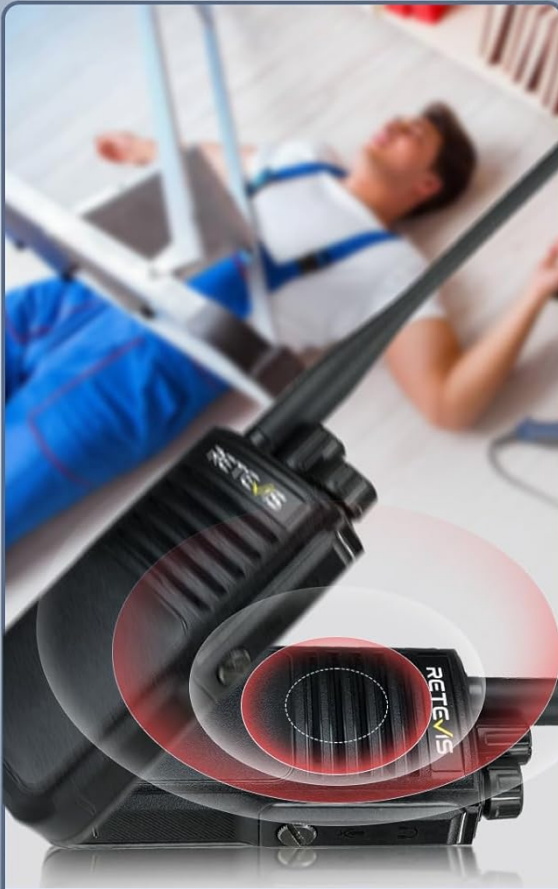


Image: Easy pairing feature of the P62.

3.4. Emergency Alarm

The P62 includes an emergency alarm function. This can be activated by pressing the up or down key after software configuration, or by a long press of the up key. These modes enhance user safety in emergency situations.

3.5. Long Range Communication

Equipped with a long antenna and 2m/70cm reception, the P62 facilitates extended-range communication, ensuring smooth and stable connections.

3.6. Noise Reduction

An integrated noise reduction chip minimizes background noise, providing clear reception even in noisy environments. This ensures important information is not missed.

3.7. VOX Hands-Free Operation

The Voice Operated Exchange (VOX) function allows transmission without pressing the Push-To-Talk (PTT) button, freeing your hands to focus on other tasks.

3.8. Side Key Function Definition

The side keys can be programmed without software to quickly activate necessary functions during use, improving operational efficiency.

4. SETUP

4.1. Battery Installation

1. Align the battery pack with the grooves on the back of the radio.
2. Slide the battery pack upwards until it clicks into place.
3. Ensure the battery is securely fastened.

4.2. Charging the Battery

The P62 walkie talkie is equipped with a 2500mAh rechargeable Lithium-ion battery. It can be charged using the provided charging base or directly via the Type-C charging cable.

1. **Using the Charging Base:** Connect the charging base to a power source using the Type-C cable. Place the walkie talkie into the charging slot. The indicator light will show charging status.
2. **Direct Type-C Charging:** Connect the Type-C cable directly to the charging port on the walkie talkie and to a power source.
3. Charge the battery fully before first use.

4.3. Attaching the Antenna

1. Screw the antenna clockwise into the connector on the top of the radio until it is finger-tight. Do not overtighten.

4.4. Attaching the Belt Clip and Hand Strap

1. Attach the belt clip to the designated slot on the back of the radio.
2. Thread the hand strap through the loop on the radio for secure carrying.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Power On/Off and Volume Control

1. **Power On:** Rotate the Power/Volume knob clockwise until a click is heard. The radio will power on.
2. **Power Off:** Rotate the Power/Volume knob counter-clockwise until a click is heard. The radio will power off.
3. **Volume Adjustment:** Rotate the Power/Volume knob to increase or decrease the volume.

5.2. Channel Selection

1. Rotate the Channel Selector knob to choose the desired channel. Ensure all radios in your group are on the same channel.

5.3. Transmitting and Receiving

1. **To Transmit:** Press and hold the Push-To-Talk (PTT) button on the side of the radio. Speak clearly into the microphone, holding the radio approximately 2-5 cm from your mouth. Release the PTT button to listen.
2. **To Receive:** Ensure the PTT button is not pressed. The radio will automatically receive signals on the selected channel.

5.4. Emergency Alarm Function

The emergency alarm can be activated in two ways:

- **Software Configured:** If configured via software, press the designated side key (up or down) to activate the alarm.
- **Manual Activation:** Long press the up key to activate the alarm.

5.5. VOX (Voice Operated Exchange)

When VOX is enabled (typically via software programming), the radio will automatically transmit when it detects your voice, eliminating the need to press the PTT button. Adjust VOX sensitivity as needed to prevent accidental transmissions or missed speech.

5.6. Side Key Customization

The programmable side keys allow for quick access to frequently used functions without requiring software. Refer to the detailed programming guide (if available) or experiment with default settings to understand their functions.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Cleaning

- Clean the radio surface with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Ensure the charging contacts are clean and free of debris.

6.2. Battery Care

- Avoid overcharging or completely discharging the battery.
- Store batteries in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- If the battery performance significantly degrades, consider replacing it with an original Retevis battery.

6.3. Storage

- Store the walkie talkie in a dry, dust-free environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Remove the battery if storing for more than a month.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Retevis P62, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Radio does not power on	Battery is low or not installed correctly.	Charge the battery or re-install it securely.
Cannot transmit or receive	Incorrect channel selected; out of range; antenna not attached.	Verify channel settings; move closer to other radios; ensure antenna is securely attached.
Poor audio quality / Static	Weak signal; interference; volume too low/high.	Move to an open area; adjust volume; check for sources of interference.
Battery drains quickly	Battery old or damaged; frequent high-power transmission.	Replace battery; reduce transmission power if possible.
