1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your IO MABE IO6062HGW11 Gas LP Oven. Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Gas Safety:** This appliance uses LP gas. Ensure proper ventilation and professional installation to prevent gas leaks. Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.
- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the oven is properly grounded. Do not operate the oven with a damaged power cord or plug.
- **Burn Hazard:** Oven surfaces become hot during operation. Use oven mitts when handling hot items. Keep children away from the oven during and after use.
- **Electronic Lock:** The electronic lock feature is designed to prevent accidental operation. Understand its function before use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The IO MABE IO6062HGW11 is a 60 cm (24-inch) built-in LP gas oven featuring a sleek black glass and stainless steel finish. It incorporates convection heating for even cooking and an electronic lock for enhanced safety.

Key Features:

- **Convection Heating:** Circulates hot air for faster and more even cooking results.

- **Electronic Lock:** Provides a safety mechanism to prevent unintended use.
- **Built-in Design:** Seamlessly integrates into your kitchen cabinetry.
- **Durable Finish:** Black glass and stainless steel construction for modern aesthetics and easy cleaning.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The IO MABE IO6062HGW11 is designed for built-in installation. Due to the nature of gas appliances, **professional installation by a qualified technician is mandatory** to ensure safety and compliance with local codes.

4.1 Pre-Installation Checklist:

- Verify that the installation area meets the required dimensions.
- Ensure proper gas supply (LP) and electrical connections are available.
- Confirm adequate ventilation in the installation area.

4.2 Dimensions:

Refer to the diagram below for precise measurements required for cabinet cutout and overall oven dimensions.

- **Height:** 59.50 cm
- **Width (Front):** 59.30 cm
- **Depth:** 54.30 cm

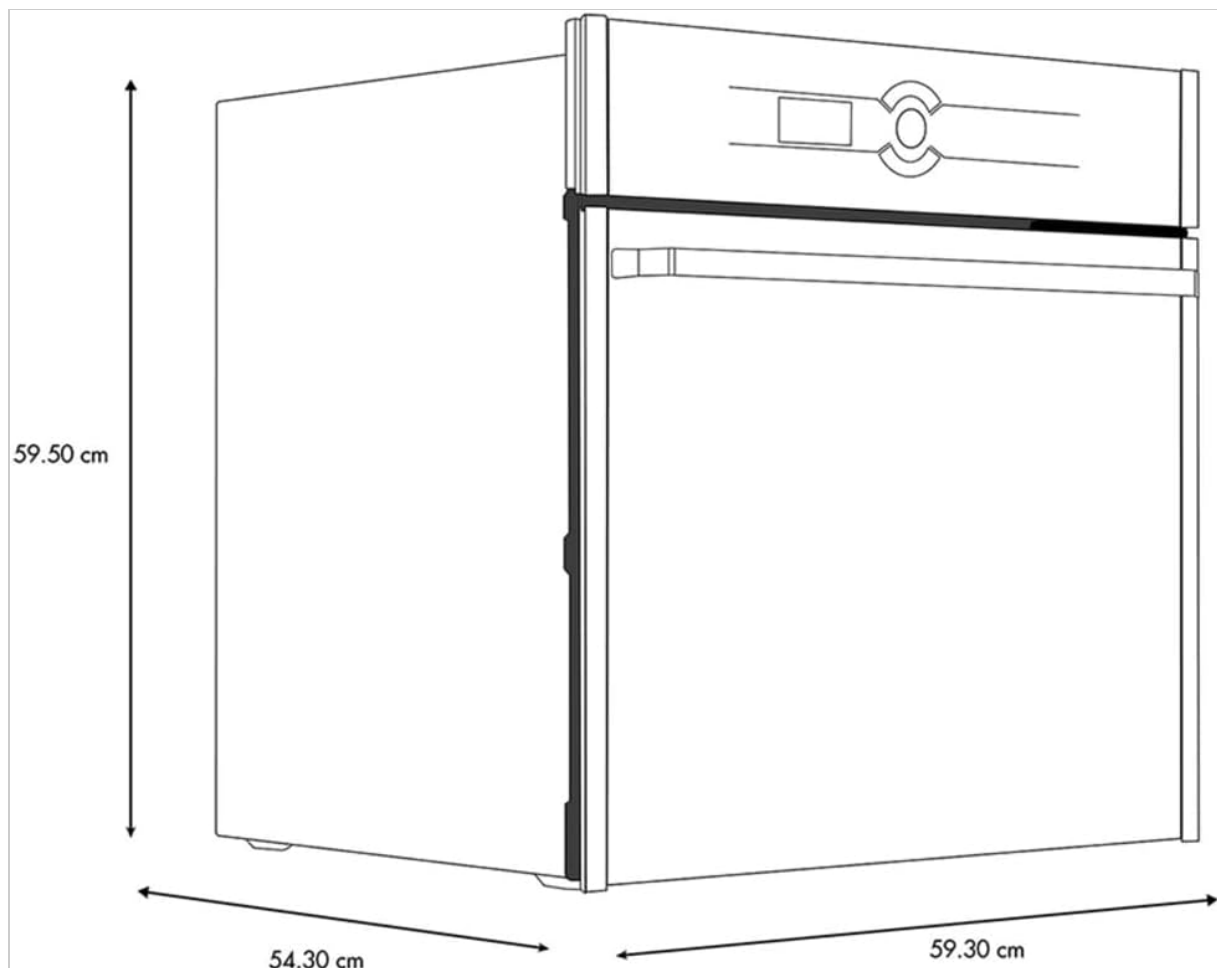


Figure 4.1: Dimensional drawing of the IO MABE IO6062HGW1 Gas LP Oven, indicating height, width, and depth for installation planning.

4.3 Post-Installation:

After installation, the technician should perform a leak test on all gas connections and verify proper operation of the oven, including the ignition system and convection fan.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the control panel before operating the oven. The control panel typically includes buttons for power, temperature settings, cooking modes, timer, and the electronic lock.

5.1 Initial Use:

1. Before first use, wipe the interior with a damp cloth.
2. Run the oven empty at 200°C (392°F) for approximately 30 minutes to burn off any manufacturing residues. Some smoke and odor are normal during this process. Ensure good ventilation.

5.2 Basic Operation:

1. **Power On:** Press the power button to activate the oven.
2. **Select Cooking Mode:** Use the mode selector to choose your desired cooking function (e.g., Bake, Convection Bake).
3. **Set Temperature:** Adjust the temperature using the temperature controls. The display will show the set temperature.
4. **Start Cooking:** Press the start button. The oven will begin preheating.
5. **Electronic Lock:** To activate or deactivate the electronic lock, refer to the specific instructions on

your control panel, usually involving a long press of a designated button. This feature prevents accidental changes to settings or operation.

5.3 Convection Cooking:

The convection feature uses a fan to circulate hot air, resulting in more even heat distribution and faster cooking times. When using convection, it is often recommended to reduce the recipe temperature by 25°F (15°C) and check for doneness earlier than traditional baking times.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your oven.

6.1 Exterior Cleaning:

- **Black Glass:** Use a soft cloth and a non-abrasive glass cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive pads that can scratch the surface.
- **Stainless Steel:** Clean with a soft cloth and a stainless steel cleaner, wiping in the direction of the grain to prevent streaks.

6.2 Interior Cleaning:

- Allow the oven to cool completely before cleaning.
- Remove oven racks and clean them separately with warm, soapy water.
- Wipe the interior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent. For stubborn stains, use an oven cleaner specifically designed for gas ovens, following the product instructions carefully.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads on the interior, as they can damage the finish.

6.3 General Maintenance:

- Periodically check the oven door seal for any signs of damage or wear. A damaged seal can affect oven performance.
- Ensure the oven is disconnected from the power supply before performing any maintenance or cleaning that involves internal components.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, review the following common issues and their potential solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not heat	No gas supply; Power outage; Electronic lock engaged; Faulty igniter.	Check gas valve; Verify power supply; Disengage electronic lock; Contact service if igniter is suspected.
Uneven cooking	Improper rack placement; Oven not preheated; Convection fan issue.	Use recommended rack positions; Allow full preheat; Contact service if convection fan is not working.
Electronic lock won't disengage	Incorrect button sequence; System glitch.	Refer to operating instructions for correct sequence; Try cycling power to the oven (turn off and on at circuit breaker).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven light not working	Bulb burned out.	Replace bulb (ensure oven is cool and power is off).
