## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Olympia Vitus 2G Senior Mobile Phone. This device is designed with ease of use in mind, featuring a foldable design, large buttons, and essential functions to keep you connected. It is also hearing aid compatible for enhanced accessibility.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1. Unboxing and Package Contents

Carefully unpack your Olympia Vitus 2G phone. The package should contain:

- Olympia Vitus 2G Senior Mobile Phone

- Charging Dock
- USB-C Charging Cable
- Power Adapter
- Battery
- User Manual (this document)

### 3.2. Battery Installation and Charging

1. Remove the back cover of the phone.
2. Insert the battery, ensuring the gold contacts align with the phone's terminals.
3. Replace the back cover.
4. Connect the USB-C charging cable to the phone or place the phone in the charging dock.
5. Connect the other end of the cable to the power adapter and plug it into a wall outlet.
6. Allow the phone to charge fully before first use. The battery indicator on the display will show charging status.

The Vitus 2G offers a standby time of up to 240 hours and a talk time of up to 3.5 hours. An automatic SMS notification will alert you when the battery level is low, prompting timely charging.

### 3.3. SIM Card Installation

1. Ensure the phone is powered off.
2. Remove the back cover and battery.
3. Locate the SIM card slot(s). This phone supports 2G cellular technology.
4. Carefully insert your SIM card(s) into the designated slot(s) with the gold contacts facing down, following the diagram usually found near the slot.
5. Reinsert the battery and replace the back cover.

### 3.4. Powering On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the **Power/End Call** button until the screen lights up.
- To power off: Press and hold the **Power/End Call** button, then select "Power off" from the options on the screen.

#### 4.1. Making and Receiving Calls

- To make a call: Dial the number using the large keypad and press the **Call** button (green receiver icon).
- To answer a call: Press the **Call** button when the phone rings.
- To end a call: Press the **End Call** button (red receiver icon).

#### 4.2. Emergency Call Button (SOS Function)

The Vitus 2G features a dedicated SOS button for emergencies. When activated, it can trigger an SOS sound alarm, send SOS SMS messages, and initiate calls to pre-programmed emergency contacts.

- To activate: Press and hold the **SOS button** on the back of the phone for a few seconds.
- Ensure emergency contacts are set up in the phone's settings for this feature to function correctly.

### 4.3. Speed Dial and Direct Dial Buttons

The phone supports image speed dialing and includes two direct dial buttons (M1, M2) for quick access to important contacts.

- To set up: Refer to the phone's menu for "Speed Dial" or "Direct Dial" settings to assign contacts to M1, M2, or other number keys.
- To use: Simply press the assigned M1 or M2 button, or hold down a number key for speed dial.

- **MicroSD Slot:** Expand storage up to 16GB for photos, music, and other files.
- **Calendar, Calculator, Alarm Clock:** Access these utility functions from the main menu.
- **Bluetooth:** Connect wirelessly to compatible devices such as headsets or other phones.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Solution
Phone does not power on	Ensure the battery is correctly installed and charged. Connect to charger and try again.
Cannot make/receive calls	Check SIM card installation. Ensure you have network signal. Contact your service provider.
Poor call quality	Move to an area with better network reception. If using a hearing aid, adjust phone position.
Battery drains quickly	Reduce screen brightness. Close unused applications. Limit background data usage.
SOS button not working	Ensure emergency contacts are correctly set up in the phone's settings.
