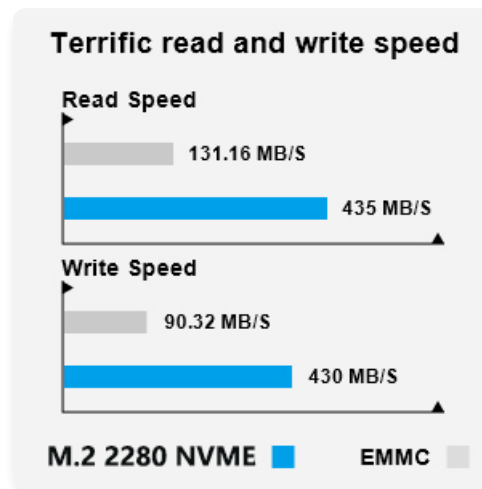


Image: Visual representation of the items included in the AWOW Mini PC package, such as the mini PC unit, power adapter, HDMI cable, and mounting bracket.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Connecting Peripherals

1. **Connect Display:** Use the provided HDMI cable to connect the Mini PC to your monitor or TV. The Mini PC supports up to four screens simultaneously via its two HDMI 2.0 ports and two full-featured Type-C ports.
2. **Connect Keyboard and Mouse:** Plug your USB keyboard and mouse into any of the available USB ports (2x USB 3.0, 2x USB 2.0).
3. **Connect Network:** For a wired connection, plug an Ethernet cable into one of the RJ45 Gigabit Ethernet ports. For wireless, the device supports 2.4G/5G WiFi.
4. **Connect Power:** Insert the power adapter into the DC Jack on the Mini PC and then plug it into a power outlet.

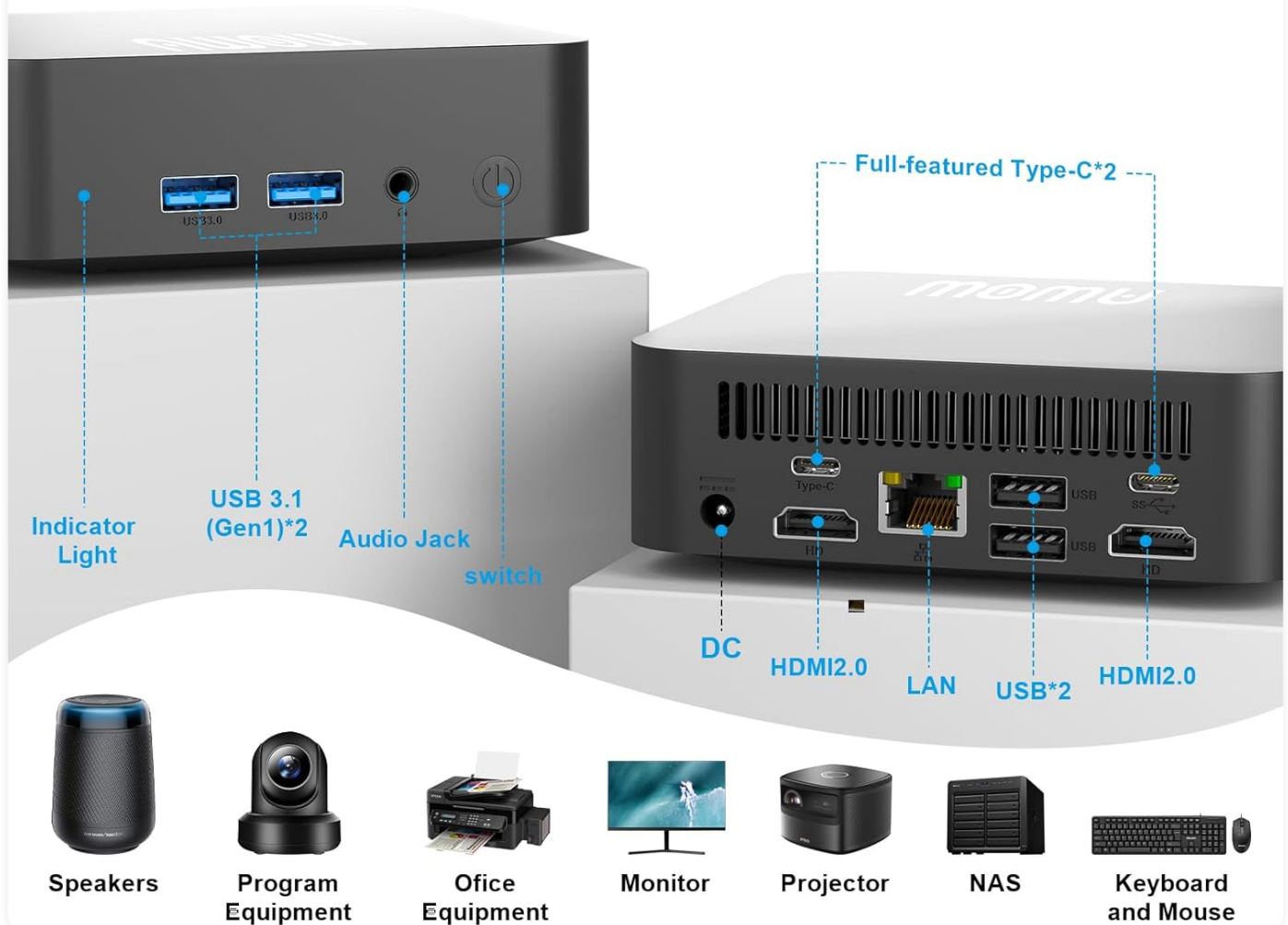


Image: Close-up view of the AWOW Mini PC's rear and side ports, including HDMI, USB, Ethernet, and Type-C, with labels indicating their functions.

Upon first boot, you will be guided through the Windows 11 Pro setup process. Follow the on-screen prompts to configure your region, language, network, and user account settings.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Multi-Screen Display

The AWOW Mini PC supports up to four displays simultaneously, providing an expansive workspace for enhanced productivity or immersive entertainment. Connect your monitors to the available HDMI and full-featured Type-C ports.

- **HDMI Ports:** Two HDMI 2.0 ports support 4K@60Hz output.
- **Type-C Ports:** Two full-featured Type-C ports also support video output.

To configure multiple displays in Windows 11 Pro:

1. Right-click on an empty area of your desktop and select "Display settings."
2. Under "Multiple displays," you can detect, identify, and arrange your monitors.
3. Choose your preferred display option: "Duplicate these displays," "Extend these displays," or "Show only on 1/2/3/4."

MAINTENANCE

- **Software Updates:** Regularly update your Windows 11 Pro operating system and drivers to ensure security and performance.
- **Power Management:** Always shut down the Mini PC properly through the operating system before disconnecting power.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No display output	Loose cable connection, incorrect input source on monitor, monitor off.	Check HDMI/Type-C cable connections. Ensure monitor is on and set to the correct input. Try a different port or cable.
Mini PC does not power on	Power adapter not connected, faulty power outlet.	Verify power adapter is securely connected to both the Mini PC and a working power outlet.
Slow performance	Too many applications running, insufficient free storage, outdated drivers.	Close unnecessary applications. Check available storage space. Update Windows and drivers.
No internet connection (wired)	Ethernet cable disconnected, router issue, network driver issue.	Check Ethernet cable connection. Restart router. Check network adapter settings in Windows.
No internet connection (wireless)	WiFi disabled, incorrect password, router issue, signal interference.	Ensure WiFi is enabled in Windows. Re-enter WiFi password. Restart router. Move closer to router.

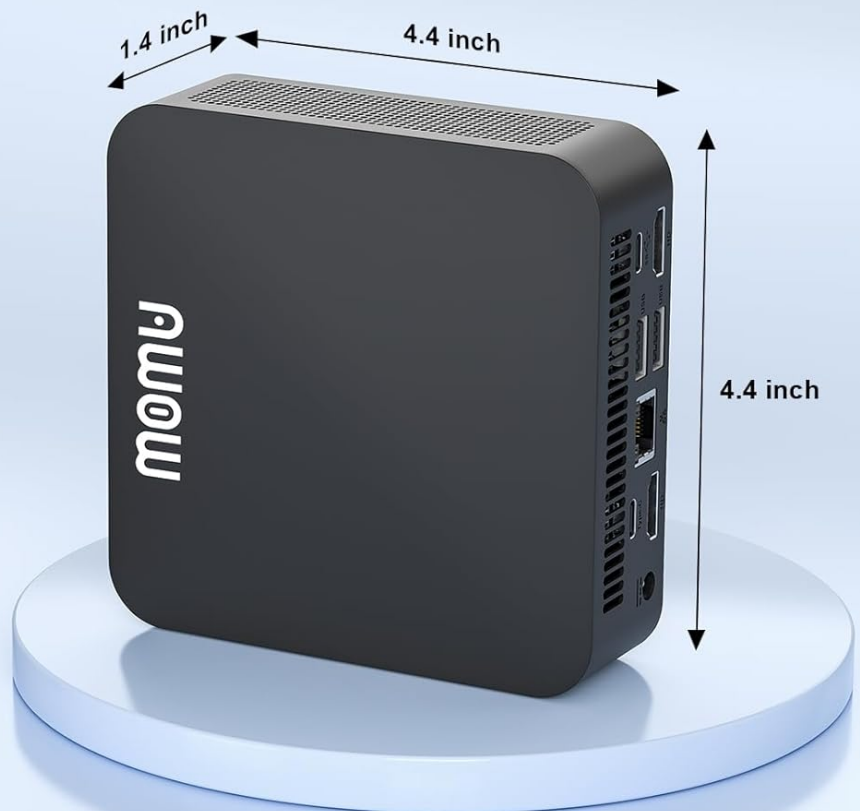


Image: The compact dimensions of the AWOW Mini PC, shown next to a smartphone for scale, highlighting its small footprint.

Intel Gen12 N100 Quad Core 3.40GHz

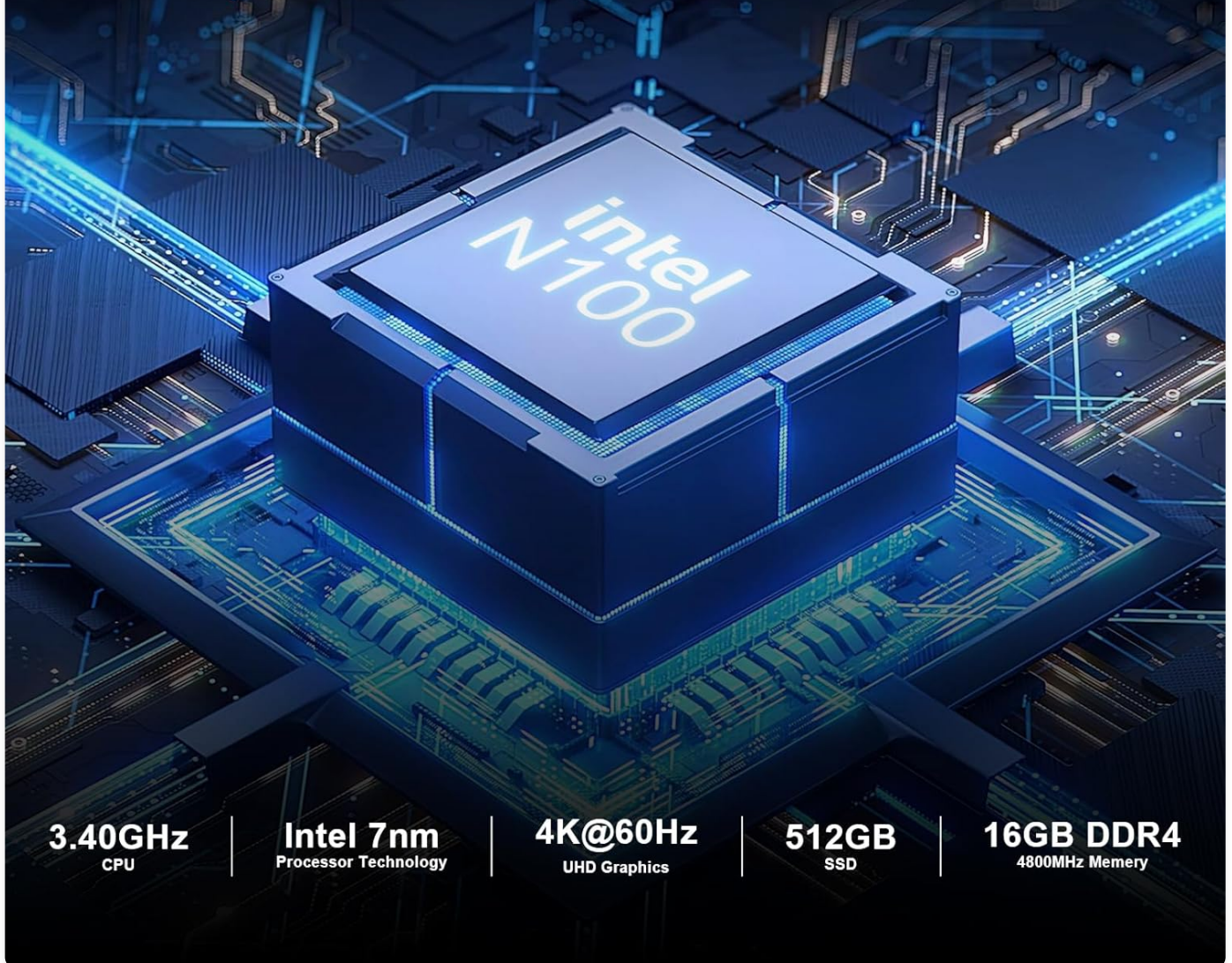


