### 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Wood support slats eliminate the need for a box spring, and the lifted design provides additional under-bed storage space.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety warnings and instructions before assembling and using this bunk bed. Failure to follow these warnings can result in serious injury.

- **Top Bunk Age Restriction:** The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Weight Limit:** The maximum weight recommendation for each bunk is 200 pounds. Do not exceed this limit.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the guardrails on both sides of the upper bunk. Ensure they are properly installed and secured.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the ladder for entering and exiting the upper bunk. Do not use the bed as a climbing frame.

- **Mattress Requirements:** Use only mattresses that are 75 inches long and 39 inches wide. The thickness of the mattress on the upper bunk must not exceed 6 inches to ensure the effectiveness of the guardrails.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **Assembly:** This product requires assembly. Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and tightened before use. Periodically check and tighten all connections.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- **Proximity to Openings:** Do not attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, or jump ropes.

### 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for straightforward assembly. It is recommended that two adults assemble the bed to ensure safety and efficiency. Please refer to the detailed installation manual included in your packaging for step-by-step instructions and a complete parts list.

#### Assembly Overview:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and hardware. Verify against the parts list in your manual.
2. **Assemble Bed Frames:** Follow the instructions to assemble the individual twin bed frames.
3. **Attach Ladder and Guardrails:** Securely attach the integrated ladder and guardrails to the upper bunk.
4. **Install Slats:** Place and secure the wood support slats for both the upper and lower bunks.
5. **Final Check:** Ensure all bolts and screws are tightened. Do not overtighten.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Once assembled, the bunk bed is ready for use. Ensure that mattresses are placed correctly on the support slats for both bunks.

- **Mattress Placement:** Position twin-size mattresses (75"L x 39"W) directly onto the wood slats.
- **Upper Bunk Access:** Always use the integrated ladder to access the upper bunk.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly on both bunks. Do not concentrate weight in one small area.
- **Under-Bed Storage:** The lifted design allows for storage underneath the lower bunk. Utilize this space for toys or other items, ensuring clear access and no obstruction to the bed structure.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bed frame with a dry cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the espresso lacquer finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, please refer to these common troubleshooting tips.

- **Squeaking Noises:** If the bed makes squeaking noises, check all hardware connections and tighten any loose bolts or screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
- **Instability:** If the bed feels unstable, re-verify that all parts are correctly assembled according to the manual and that all fasteners are securely tightened.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing or damaged upon arrival, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support immediately for replacement parts.
