TCL 40-Inch Class 3-Series FHD LED Smart Android TV Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

4. SETUP

4.1 Installing the TV Stand

1. Carefully place the TV face-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent screen damage.
2. Align the stand legs with the screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure each leg with the provided screws using a screwdriver.
4. Carefully lift the TV and place it on a stable, level surface.

4.2 Wall Mounting (Optional)

If you choose to wall mount your TV, please refer to the instructions provided with your specific wall mount kit. Ensure the wall mount is compatible with your TV's VESA mounting pattern and weight. Professional installation is recommended for wall mounting.

4.3 Connecting Peripherals

Your TCL Android TV offers various ports for connecting external devices:

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, cable boxes, etc.
- **USB Port:** For media playback from USB drives.

The Android TV home screen provides quick access to your favorite apps, movies, shows, and settings. Use the directional pad on your remote to navigate through the interface.

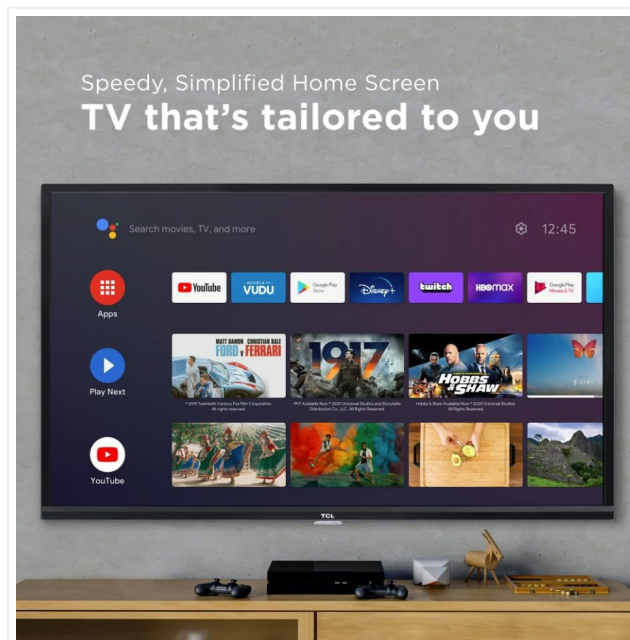


Figure 5.1: The intuitive Android TV home screen.

Access thousands of apps from the Google Play Store directly on your TV. Popular streaming services like Netflix, YouTube, Prime Video, and more are readily available.

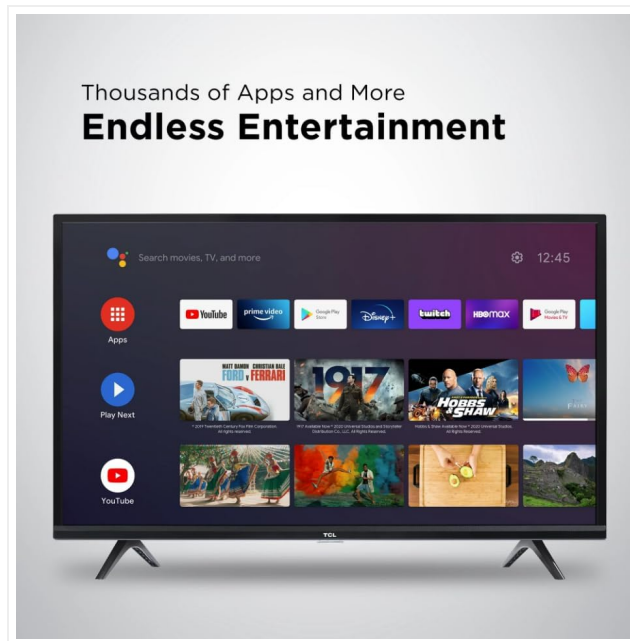


Figure 5.2: A selection of available streaming applications on Android TV.

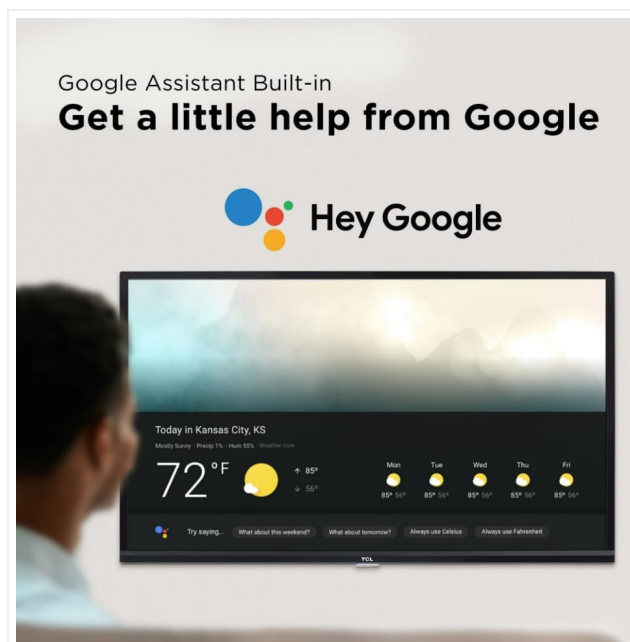


Figure 5.3: Interacting with Google Assistant on your TV.

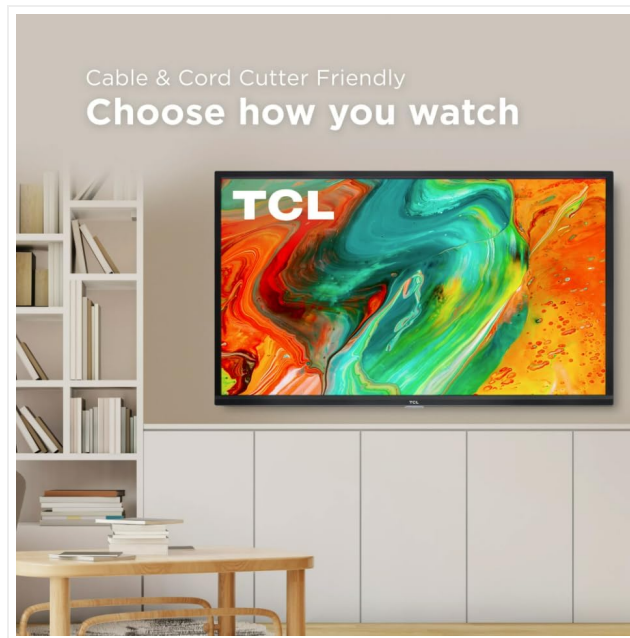


Figure 5.4: Seamless content casting with Chromecast built-in.

- **Network Connection Issues:** Restart your Wi-Fi router. Check the TV's network settings to ensure it's connected to the correct network.
- **Frozen Screen/App Issues:** Restart the TV by unplugging it from the power outlet for 30 seconds, then plugging it back in.







Figure 9.1: Physical dimensions of the TCL 40-Inch Smart Android TV.
