INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Farberware 0.9 Cu. Ft. Countertop Microwave Oven. This manual provides important information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your microwave oven. Please read it thoroughly before use and keep it for future reference.

This compact 900-watt white microwave oven is designed for convenience, featuring 6 one-touch cooking programs, 10 power levels, and a child safety lock. Its 0.9 cubic foot capacity makes it suitable for various kitchen sizes.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in closed containers since they are liable to explode.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not use this appliance for other than its intended use.
- Always ensure the turntable and roller ring are correctly positioned before operation.
- Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open as this can result in harmful exposure to microwave energy.
- Do not allow the cord to hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- To reduce the risk of fire in the oven cavity:
 - Do not overcook food.
 - Remove wire twist-ties from paper or plastic bags before placing bags in oven.
 - If materials inside the oven should ignite, keep oven door closed, turn oven off, and disconnect the power cord.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials from inside the oven cavity.
- Inspect the oven for any damage, such as dents or a misaligned door. Do not operate if damaged.
- Ensure all components are present: microwave oven, glass turntable, and roller ring.

Placement

- Place the microwave oven on a flat, stable surface capable of supporting its weight (approximately 26.6 lbs).
- Ensure adequate ventilation. Maintain a minimum of 3 inches (7.5 cm) clearance from the rear and sides, and 12 inches (30 cm) above the oven.
- Keep the oven away from heat sources and strong magnetic fields.
- This model is designed for countertop use and fits standard 30-inch wide cabinets.

Electrical Requirements

- The oven requires a standard 120V, 60Hz AC outlet with a minimum 15A circuit.
- Do not use an extension cord. If the power cord is too short, have a qualified electrician install an outlet near the appliance.

Control Panel Overview

The control panel features a digital display, function buttons, number pad, and start/stop buttons.

- **Time Cook:** Manually set cooking time.
- **Time Defrost / Weight Defrost:** Options for defrosting food.

- **Power:** Adjust power levels (1-10).
- **Clock:** Set the current time.
- **Kitchen Timer:** Use as a standalone timer.
- **One-Touch Cook Programs:** Popcorn, Potato, Pizza, Frozen Vegetable, Beverage, Dinner Plate.
- **Express Cook (1-6):** Start cooking immediately for 1 to 6 minutes at 100% power.
- **+30 Sec:** Add 30 seconds to cooking time or start quick cook.
- **STOP/CANCEL:** Stop cooking or clear settings.
- **START:** Begin cooking.
- **Memory:** Save and recall custom cooking settings.

Setting the Clock

1. Press the **CLOCK** button once.
2. Use the number pad to enter the current time (e.g., 12:30 for 12:30 PM).
3. Press the **CLOCK** button again to confirm.

Microwave Cooking

1. Place food in a microwave-safe container on the turntable.
2. Close the door securely.
3. **Manual Cooking:**
 - Press **TIME COOK**.
 - Enter desired cooking time using the number pad.
 - Press **POWER**, then enter a power level (1-10) using the number pad (10 is 100% power).
 - Press **START**.
4. **Express Cooking:**
 - Press any number from **1** to **6** for instant cooking at 100% power for that many minutes.
 - Alternatively, press **+30 SEC** to start cooking for 30 seconds at 100% power. Press repeatedly to add 30-second increments.
5. **One-Touch Cook Programs:**
 - Press the desired program button (e.g., **POPCORN**, **POTATO**). The oven will automatically set the appropriate cooking time and power level.
 - Press **START**.

Defrosting

The microwave offers two defrost options: Time Defrost and Weight Defrost.

- **Time Defrost:**
 1. Press **TIME DEFROST**.
 2. Enter the desired defrosting time using the number pad.
 3. Press **START**.
- **Weight Defrost:**
 1. Press **WEIGHT DEFROST**.
 2. Enter the food weight in ounces using the number pad.
 3. Press **START**.

Child Safety Lock

To prevent unsupervised operation, especially by children, activate the child safety lock.

- **To Activate:** Press and hold the **STOP/CANCEL** button for 3 seconds. A lock indicator will appear on the display.
- **To Deactivate:** Press and hold the **STOP/CANCEL** button for 3 seconds again. The lock indicator will disappear.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning helps maintain the performance and longevity of your microwave oven.

- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth and mild soap. Dry thoroughly.
- **Interior:** For spills and splatters, wipe the interior with a damp cloth immediately. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and microwave for 2-3 minutes. The steam will loosen food particles, making them easier to wipe away.
- **Turntable and Roller Ring:** These can be removed and washed in warm, soapy water or in the dishwasher. Ensure they are completely dry before returning them to the oven.
- **Door Seals:** Keep the door seals clean to ensure proper closure and efficient operation.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals on any part of the microwave.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

If you encounter issues with your microwave oven, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven will not start	Door not closed properly. Plug not inserted firmly into outlet. Fuse blown or circuit breaker tripped. Child safety lock is active.	Close the door securely. Unplug and re-plug the unit. Replace fuse or reset circuit breaker. Deactivate child safety lock (hold STOP/CANCEL for 3 seconds).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Food not heating	Incorrect cooking time or power level set. Door not closed properly.	Adjust cooking time and power level. Ensure door is securely closed.
Turntable not rotating	Turntable or roller ring not positioned correctly. Food too large or heavy, obstructing rotation.	Re-position turntable and roller ring. Use a smaller dish or ensure food does not obstruct rotation.
Sparkling or arcing inside oven	Metal or foil in the oven. Food residue on oven walls.	Remove all metal objects. Use only microwave-safe dishes. Clean the oven interior thoroughly.


