PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
2. Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PC), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "PowerLocus P6" from the list of devices.
5. Once paired, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly or turn solid blue.

3. Connecting to Multiple Devices (Multi-Point)

The PowerLocus P6 headphones support multi-point connection, allowing you to connect to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously. This is useful for switching between a phone and a laptop without re-pairing.

1. Pair the headphones with the first device as described above.
2. Disable Bluetooth on the first device. The headphones will re-enter pairing mode.
3. Pair the headphones with the second device.
4. Re-enable Bluetooth on the first device. The headphones should automatically connect to both devices.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.

Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Down button.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the Volume Up button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the Volume Down button.

Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Multi-function button.

Voice Assistant

- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Triple-press the Multi-function button (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant).

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the surface or internal components.

Storage

When not in use, store the headphones in their hard-shell carry case to protect them from dust, scratches,

and impacts. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; Bluetooth disabled on device; device too far.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Enable Bluetooth on your device. Move device closer to headphones (within 10 meters).
No sound or poor sound quality.	Volume too low; headphones not connected; interference.	Increase volume on both headphones and device. Reconnect headphones. Move away from other wireless devices.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Microphone not working.	Microphone muted on device; incorrect audio input selected.	Check device settings to ensure microphone is not muted and PowerLocus P6 is selected as the input device.
