INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your JBL Boombox 2 Portable Bluetooth Speaker and JBL Vibe Beam True Wireless Headphones. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your devices.

1. SETUP

1.1 JBL Boombox 2 Speaker Setup

1. **Charging:** Connect the power cable to the Boombox 2 and a power outlet. The battery indicator lights will show charging progress. A full charge takes approximately 6.5 hours.
2. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button located on the top panel to turn the speaker on or off.
3. **Bluetooth Pairing:**
 - Turn on the Boombox 2.
 - Press the Bluetooth button on the top panel. The Bluetooth indicator will flash.
 - On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and select "JBL Boombox 2" from the list of available devices.
 - Once connected, the Bluetooth indicator will glow solid.

1.2 JBL Vibe Beam Headphones Setup

1. **Charging:** Place the earbuds into the charging case. Connect the USB-C cable to the charging case and a power source. The LED indicators on the case will show charging status.
2. **Power On/Off:** The earbuds automatically power on when removed from the case and power off when placed back in the case.
3. **Bluetooth Pairing:**
 - Open the charging case. The earbuds will enter pairing mode automatically.
 - On your device, enable Bluetooth and select "JBL Vibe Beam" from the list of available devices.
 - Once connected, a confirmation sound will play.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 JBL Boombox 2 Speaker Operation

- **Volume Control:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the top panel to adjust the volume.
- **Play/Pause:** Press the play/pause button to control music playback.
- **JBL PartyBoost:** Press the PartyBoost button to connect with other JBL PartyBoost-compatible speakers for a synchronized audio experience. Refer to the JBL PartyBoost guide for detailed instructions on linking multiple speakers.
- **Powerbank Feature:** The Boombox 2 includes a built-in powerbank. Connect your mobile device to the USB port on the back of the speaker to charge it.

2.2 JBL Vibe Beam Headphones Operation

- **Touch Controls:** The earbuds feature touch-sensitive areas for controlling playback, calls, and voice assistant activation. Refer to the quick start guide for specific tap patterns.
- **Hands-free Calls with VoiceAware:** When making calls, VoiceAware allows you to adjust the amount of your own voice you hear, enhancing call clarity.
- **Battery Life:** The earbuds provide up to 32 total hours of battery life with the charging case.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning

- **JBL Boombox 2:** Wipe the speaker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or submerge the speaker in water for cleaning.
- **JBL Vibe Beam Headphones:** Gently clean the earbuds and charging case with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid using liquids directly on the earbuds.

3.2 Water and Dust Resistance

- **JBL Boombox 2:** The Boombox 2 is IPX7 waterproof, meaning it can be submerged in up to 1 meter of water for up to 30 minutes. Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed before exposure to water.
- **JBL Vibe Beam Headphones:** The earbuds are IP54-certified for splash and dust resistance, and the charging case is IPX2-certified for splash resistance. This protects against light splashes and dust, but they are not designed for full submersion.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

4.1 Common Issues & Solutions

- **No Power:** Ensure the device is charged. For Boombox 2, check the power cable connection.
- **No Sound:** Check volume levels on both the device and the speaker/headphones. Ensure Bluetooth is connected.
- **Bluetooth Disconnection:** Move the devices closer together. Disconnect and re-pair the Bluetooth connection. Ensure no other devices are interfering.
- **Poor Sound Quality:** Ensure the audio source is of good quality. Check for obstructions between the devices.
- **Headphones Not Charging:** Ensure earbuds are correctly seated in the charging case. Check the charging case battery level.
