1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your Xprinter XP-P323B Portable Thermal Printer. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper functionality and to prevent damage. The XP-P323B is designed for printing receipts and labels, offering portability and high-speed capabilities for various business needs.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the printer to water or excessive moisture.
- Avoid dropping the printer or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Use only the specified power adapter and accessories.
- Keep the printer away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the printer yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation during operation.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Xprinter XP-P323B is a compact and efficient thermal printer designed for various printing tasks. It supports

5. SETUP

5.1. Charging the Battery

- 1. Connect the power adapter to the printer's charging port.
- 2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
- 3. The charging indicator light will illuminate. Allow the printer to charge fully before first use.

5.2. Loading Thermal Paper/Labels

- 1. Open the paper compartment cover by gently pushing the release latch.
- 2. Insert the thermal paper roll with the printing surface facing the print head. Ensure the roll is seated correctly.
- 3. Pull a small amount of paper out past the print head.
- 4. Close the paper compartment cover firmly until it clicks into place.

5.3. Connecting to a Device

The XP-P323B supports USB and Bluetooth connectivity.

5.3.1. USB Connection

- 1. Connect the printer to your computer using the provided USB cable.
- 2. Install the necessary printer drivers (available from the Xprinter website or included software).

5.3.2. Bluetooth Connection (for Smartphones/iOS)

- 1. Ensure the printer is powered on.
- 2. On your smartphone or iOS device, go to Bluetooth settings and enable Bluetooth.
- 3. Search for available devices and select 'XP-P323B' (or similar name).
- 4. Enter the pairing PIN if prompted (refer to printer documentation for default PIN, often '0000' or '1234').
- 5. Once paired, you can use a compatible printing application to send print jobs.

6. OPERATING THE PRINTER

6.1. Basic Printing

- 1. Ensure the printer is connected to your device and has paper loaded.
- 2. Open the document or image you wish to print on your connected device.

- 3. Select the print option within your application.
- 4. Choose 'XP-P323B' as the printer.
- 5. Adjust print settings as needed (e.g., paper size, print quality).
- 6. Initiate the print job.

6.2. NV Logo and Picture Printing

The printer supports downloading and printing NV (Non-Volatile) logos and BMP format pictures. This functionality typically requires specific software or commands. Refer to the advanced programming guide or software documentation for detailed instructions on how to upload and print custom logos or images.

6.3. Adjusting Print Concentration

Print concentration can be adjusted to optimize print quality. This setting is usually accessible through the printer driver software on a computer or within the settings of a compatible mobile printing application. Consult your software's help section for specific steps.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1. Cleaning the Printer

- Exterior: Wipe the exterior of the printer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Print Head:** The thermal print head should be cleaned periodically to ensure optimal print quality. Use a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol. Gently wipe the print head surface. Allow it to dry completely before closing the cover and resuming operation.
- Paper Path: Remove any paper dust or debris from the paper path using a soft brush or compressed air.

7.2. Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the printer in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Remove the paper roll if storing for a very long time to prevent dust accumulation.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Printer does not power on	Low battery; Power adapter not connected; Faulty power adapter	Charge the battery; Ensure power adapter is securely connected; Try a different power outlet or adapter
No print output	No paper; Paper loaded incorrectly; Printer not connected; Driver issue	Load paper correctly; Re-establish connection; Reinstall printer drivers
Poor print quality	Dirty print head; Low print concentration; Low battery	Clean the print head; Adjust print concentration in software; Charge the battery
Bluetooth connection fails	Bluetooth off on device; Incorrect pairing PIN; Printer out of range	Enable Bluetooth; Re-enter correct PIN; Move device closer to printer
