Introduction

The RESTMO 4-Outlet Sprinkler Timer is designed to automate your garden, yard, and lawn watering schedules with precision and ease. Featuring four independent zones, this programmable water timer allows you to manage different irrigation areas from a single faucet. It offers versatile modes including automatic, manual, and rain delay, ensuring flexible control over your watering needs. Built with durable, leak-proof materials, it is ideal for various outdoor watering applications.

Product Features

- 4 Independent Zones: Control up to four separate watering areas from one faucet.
- Multi-Functional Modes: Auto, Manual, and Rain Delay modes for flexible watering schedules.

Setup and Installation

1. Battery Installation

The timer requires 4 AA alkaline batteries (not included). Locate the battery compartment on the back of the unit. Slide the battery tray out, insert the batteries according to the polarity indicators, and slide the tray back in until it clicks securely. Ensure the compartment is properly sealed to maintain waterproof integrity.

2. Attaching to Faucet

Screw the timer's brass inlet directly onto your outdoor faucet. Hand-tighten until secure. Do not overtighten. The 360° swivel inlet allows for easy positioning without twisting the entire unit.

3. Connecting Hoses

Connect your garden hoses or drip irrigation lines to the four independent outlets at the bottom of the timer.

Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.

4. Optional Wall Mounting

For added stability, especially with multiple hoses, use the included wall mounting bracket. Attach the supporting part to the back of the timer using the provided small screws. Then, mark a suitable position on a wooden post or wall near your faucet, drill a pilot hole, and secure the bracket using the larger screw.

Operating Instructions

1. Setting the Clock

Turn the control dial to 'SET CLOCK'. Use the '+' and '-' buttons to adjust the current time. Press 'OK' to switch between setting hours and minutes. Once set, turn the dial to 'ON' to save changes.

2. Programming Start Time

Turn the control dial to 'START TIME'. Press the 'ZONE' button to select the desired watering zone (1, 2, 3, or 4). Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the specific start time for that zone. Press 'OK' to confirm. Repeat for other zones as needed.

3. Setting Watering Duration ('HOW LONG')

Turn the control dial to 'HOW LONG'. Press the 'ZONE' button to select the desired watering zone. Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the watering duration (from 1 minute to 3 hours 59 minutes). Press 'OK' to confirm. Repeat for other zones. If duration is set to 0 hour and 0 minute, the program for that zone will not run.

4. Setting Watering Frequency ('HOW OFTEN')

Turn the control dial to 'HOW OFTEN'. Press the 'ZONE' button to select the desired watering zone. Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the watering frequency (from 1 hour to 12 hours, or from 1 day to 7 days). Press 'OK' to confirm. Repeat for other zones. Note: If 'HOW LONG' is greater than 'HOW OFTEN', the program will automatically skip cycles until the duration fits the frequency.

5. Activating Automatic Watering

After programming all desired settings, turn the control dial to 'ON'. The timer will now operate according to your programmed schedule. The LCD screen will flash between the next watering start time and the current time when watering is OFF, and display the remaining time of the current program when watering is ON.

Manual Watering

To manually water without interrupting preset programs, turn the dial to 'ON'. Long press the 'OK/MANUAL' button (3 seconds). Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the desired watering duration (from 1 minute to 6 hours). Press 'OK' to confirm. The selected zone(s) will start watering immediately. To cancel manual mode, turn the dial to 'OFF' and then back to 'ON'.

Rain Delay Function

To temporarily pause your watering schedule due to rain, turn the dial to 'ON'. Long press the '+/DELAY' button (3 seconds). Use the '+' and '-' buttons to select a delay period of 0, 24, 48, or 72 hours. Press 'OK' to confirm. The timer will pause for the selected duration and then resume its programmed schedule. To cancel the rain delay, long press the '+/DELAY' button again.

Turning Off Valves

To turn off a specific valve or all valves, turn the dial to 'HOW LONG'. Press the 'ZONE' button to select the zone you wish to turn off. Use the '-' button to set the hour to 0 and the minute to 0. Press 'OK' to confirm. This will effectively turn off the valve for that zone. Repeat for other zones as needed. Alternatively, turning the dial to 'OFF' will stop all watering.

If you experience issues with valve operation or for initial setup, you can perform a self-test to reset the valves:

- 1. Attach the timer to your faucet.
- 2. Turn the faucet to maximum water flow.
- 3. Remove the battery case and wait for the screen to turn blank (this may take 1-2 minutes).
- 4. Keep the dial at the 'ON' position.
- 5. Press and hold the 'OK/MANUAL' button. Insert the battery case back at the same time.
- 6. Release the 'OK/MANUAL' button. The four valves will start a self-test, opening and closing in sequence.
- 7. You can repeat this test until all four valves work well.
- 8. After all valves work well, remove the battery case to stop the self-test. Wait for the screen to turn blank, then re-insert the battery case. You can now use the timer.

Maintenance

- Battery Replacement: When the low battery indicator appears on the display, replace all four AA batteries with new ones immediately to avoid interrupting programmed operations.
- Cleaning: Periodically clean the timer's exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Filter Cleaning:** The brass inlet contains a filter to prevent debris from entering the timer. Periodically remove the timer from the faucet and clean the filter screen.
- Winterization: Before the first frost, disconnect the timer from the faucet and hoses. Remove the batteries. Store the timer indoors in a dry, frost-free location to prevent damage from freezing water.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Timer not turning on/display blank	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries.	Replace batteries with new ones, ensuring correct polarity.
Water not flowing/valve not opening	Low water pressure; valve stuck; program error; filter clogged.	Check water pressure (8-120 PSI required). Perform valve self-test. Clean inlet filter. Verify program settings.
Water leaking from connections	Loose connections; worn washers; damaged threads.	Tighten all connections. Replace old or damaged washers. Ensure brass inlet is not cross-threaded.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Timer not following schedule	Incorrect programming; low batteries; rain delay active.	Review and re-program schedule. Replace batteries. Check if rain delay is active and cancel if necessary.
