#### INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your PORTAL 6/8/10 Person Family Camping Tent. Designed for comfort and durability, this tent features a spacious interior, screen room, and weather-resistant construction, making it ideal for various outdoor adventures. ## SAFETY INFORMATION

- Keep all flame and heat sources away from this tent fabric. The tent is made of flame-resistant fabric, but it is not fireproof.
- Do not use gas or charcoal burning devices inside the tent. Carbon monoxide poisoning can be fatal.
- Ensure proper ventilation to prevent condensation and maintain air quality.
- Do not pitch the tent near steep cliffs, unstable ground, or potential falling hazards.
- Securely stake down all corners and guylines to prevent the tent from blowing away in windy conditions.
- Avoid setting up the tent under trees with dead branches that could fall.
- In case of severe weather, evacuate the tent and seek appropriate shelter.

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The PORTAL Family Camping Tent is designed for easy setup, typically taking two people about 15 minutes. Follow these steps for a quick and secure pitch:

- 1. Choose a Site: Select a flat, clear area free of sharp objects and debris.
- 2. **Unpack and Lay Out:** Remove the tent and all components from the carry bag. Lay the tent body flat on the ground, ensuring the floor is spread out evenly.
- 3. **Assemble Poles:** Connect the fiberglass roof poles and iron leg poles. The poles are color-coded to match the tent sleeves for easy identification.
- 4. Insert Poles: Slide the assembled poles through the corresponding sleeves on the tent body.
- 5. **Raise the Tent:** Insert the ends of the poles into the grommets at the tent's base. Carefully lift the tent, allowing the poles to flex and form the tent's structure.
- 6. **Secure the Tent:** Stake down all four corners of the tent firmly into the ground. Then, extend and stake out all guylines for added stability, especially in windy conditions.
- 7. **Attach Rainfly:** Drape the rainfly over the tent body, aligning the doors and windows. Secure the rainfly to the tent poles and stake out any additional guylines on the rainfly.
- 8. **Set up Screen Room:** The screen room is integrated. Ensure its mesh walls are fully extended and zipped to create a bugfree space.

## **OPERATING YOUR TENT**

Maximize your camping experience with these operational tips:

- **Ventilation:** Utilize the mesh ceiling, windows, and doors for excellent airflow. This helps reduce condensation and keeps the interior fresh.
- Screen Room Use: The integrated screen room provides a bug-free area for relaxation, dining, or storing gear. It can also serve as a mudroom to keep the main sleeping area clean.
- E-Port: Use the E-port to conveniently run electrical cords into the tent while maintaining weather protection.
- Storage Pockets: Keep your essentials organized using the multiple wall storages and tablet entertainment pocket.
- **Night Sky Views:** For clear nights, remove the rainfly to enjoy panoramic views of the night sky through the full mesh ceiling.

#### MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your tent:

- Cleaning: Hand wash the tent with mild soap and water. Do not use harsh detergents or bleach.
- Drying: Always ensure the tent is completely dry before packing it away to prevent mildew and odor.
- Storage: Store the tent in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Pole Care: Inspect poles for any damage or bending before and after each use. Replace any damaged poles promptly.
- **Fabric Care:** The 66D fabric with water-resistant coating provides excellent weather protection. If water repellency diminishes over time, consider applying a tent-specific waterproofing spray.




Figure 6: The tent's water-resistant fabric ensures a dry interior.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tent is unstable/flimsy	Not properly staked or guylines are loose.	Ensure all stakes are firmly in the ground and guylines are taut.
Water leaking inside	Rainfly not properly positioned or damaged; condensation.	Check rainfly alignment. Ensure proper ventilation to reduce condensation. Apply waterproofing spray if fabric is worn.
Difficulty with pole assembly	Incorrect pole matching or obstruction.	Refer to color-coded instructions. Ensure pole sections are fully connected and clear of debris.
Zippers sticking	Dirt or debris in zipper teeth.	Clean zippers with a brush and apply a silicone-based zipper lubricant.


