IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions and safety warnings before assembling and using this bunk bed. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Always use the ladder to access the top bunk. Do not climb on the guardrails or any other part of the bed.
- Keep the area around the bunk bed clear of obstructions to prevent falls.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight limit of **200 lbs (90.7 kg)** for the upper bed, lower bed, and ladder.
- Ensure all connections are securely tightened before use and check periodically.
- Only use mattresses that comply with the recommended thickness (≤ 6 inches) to ensure proper guardrail height.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed.
- Use of a night light may provide added safety for a child using the upper bunk.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Giantex Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed is designed as a space-saving sleeping solution, featuring a solid wood frame and sturdy plywood slats for durability. It includes two integrated storage drawers and a convertible storage cube for added functionality.

Key Features:

- **Solid Wood Construction:** Crafted from pine wood and engineered wood for stability and long-term use.
- **Integrated Storage:** Two spacious pull-out drawers for organizing clothes, toys, or books.
- **Convertible Storage Cube:** A small storage cube that can be positioned on the top or in the middle of the guardrails.
- **Safety Guardrails:** Full-length 12-inch guardrails on the top bunk for enhanced safety.

- **Sturdy Ladder:** A firm 4-step ladder provides secure access to the upper bunk.
- **No Box Spring Required:** Plywood slats offer direct mattress support.



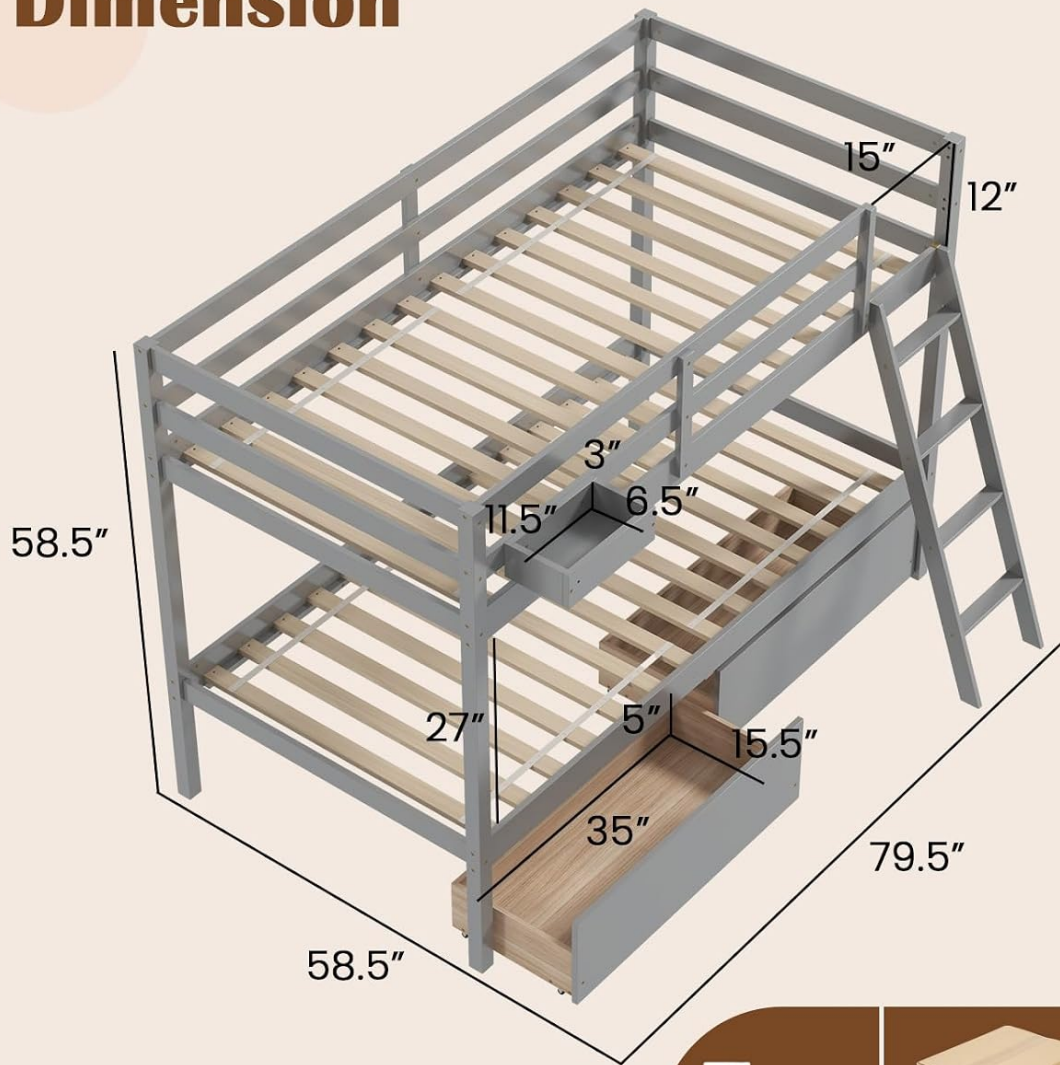
Image: The Giantex Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed in a child's room, illustrating its design and integrated storage drawers.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed requires assembly. It is recommended that two adults assemble the bed. Ensure all parts are present before beginning assembly. Refer to the included installation manual for detailed step-by-step instructions and diagrams.

General Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all components and hardware. Lay them out and compare with the parts list in your separate assembly manual to ensure nothing is missing or damaged.
2. **Assemble Bed Frames:** Begin by assembling the headboards and footboards for both the upper and lower bunks. Attach side rails to form the rectangular bed frames.
3. **Install Support Slats:** Secure the plywood slats onto the bed frames. Ensure they are evenly spaced and firmly attached to provide adequate mattress support.

4. **Attach Ladder:** Securely attach the 4-step ladder to the designated side of the bunk bed frame.
5. **Assemble Storage Drawers:** Put together the two pull-out storage drawers according to the instructions, ensuring the smooth rolling casters are correctly installed.
6. **Install Storage Cube:** Assemble the convertible storage cube. Decide whether to install it on the top guardrail or in the middle section, as per your preference, and secure it.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.
8. **Placement:** Position the assembled bunk bed in its desired location, ensuring it is stable and level.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Bunk Beds:

- **Accessing the Top Bunk:** Always use the provided 4-step ladder to safely climb to and descend from the top bunk.

Ensure a firm grip on the ladder rails.

- **Mattress Placement:** Place a twin-size mattress on both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure the mattress thickness for the upper bunk does not exceed 6 inches to maintain the effectiveness of the guardrails.

Using the Storage Drawers:

- The two large drawers are located underneath the lower bunk. Gently pull the drawers out using the integrated handles.
- Store items such as bedding, clothing, or toys within the drawers. Do not overload the drawers beyond their 44 lbs (20 kg) weight capacity.
- Push the drawers back in completely when not in use to keep the area tidy and prevent tripping hazards.

Using the Convertible Storage Cube:

- The small storage cube can be installed on the top guardrail or in the middle section of the guardrails.
- Use the cube to store small items like books, a water bottle, or a small night light. Do not exceed its 22 lbs (10 kg) weight capacity.
- Ensure the cube is securely attached in its chosen position.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the bed frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Drawer Casters:** Ensure the casters on the storage drawers are clean and free of debris for smooth operation.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** Protect the wood from prolonged exposure to moisture or extreme temperature changes.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Bed Feels Wobbly:** Check all assembly hardware. Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened. If the bed is on an uneven surface, try repositioning it or using shims to level it.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Inspect the drawer casters for any trapped debris or hair. Clean the casters and ensure they are properly aligned within their tracks.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking can often be resolved by tightening all hardware. If the noise persists, disassemble and reassemble the affected section, ensuring all parts are correctly aligned.
- **Missing Parts:** If you find any parts missing during assembly, refer to your original packaging and contact customer support with your model number and a description of the missing part.
