1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Haam Electric HMCFL13D8SM 13kg Front Load Washing Machine. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and operation, and keep them for future reference.

This washing machine is designed for household use, offering 14 diverse washing programs and high energy efficiency to ensure optimal laundry care with reduced energy consumption and noise.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent personal injury or property damage, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Ensure the washing machine is properly grounded to avoid electrical shock.
- Do not allow children to play with or operate the appliance.
- Keep flammable materials away from the machine.
- Do not wash items that have been cleaned, washed, soaked, or spotted with combustible or explosive substances.
- Always unplug the machine before cleaning, maintenance, or if it will be unused for an extended period.
- Do not open the detergent dispenser or door during a wash cycle, especially when the water temperature is high.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Ensure all transit bolts are removed from the rear of the machine before use. Failure to do so may cause severe vibration and damage.

3.2 Location Requirements

Place the washing machine on a firm, level surface. Avoid direct sunlight or extreme temperatures. Ensure there is

adequate space for ventilation and access to water supply and drainage.

3.3 Connecting Water Hoses

Connect the inlet hose to the cold water tap and the corresponding inlet valve on the back of the machine. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.

3.4 Connecting Drain Hose

Securely attach the drain hose to a standpipe or laundry tub, ensuring it is not kinked or blocked. The end of the drain hose should be positioned at a height between 60 cm and 100 cm from the floor.

3.5 Power Connection

Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

3.6 Leveling the Machine

Adjust the leveling feet at the bottom of the machine until it is perfectly stable and level. Use a spirit level to verify. Proper leveling reduces vibration and noise during operation.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The washing machine features an LED display and push-button controls for easy program selection and setting adjustments. The display shows cycle status, time remaining, and selected options.

4.2 Loading Laundry

Open the door and load laundry into the drum. Do not overload the machine; ensure there is enough space for clothes to tumble freely. Close the door firmly.

4.3 Adding Detergent and Softener

Pull out the detergent dispenser drawer. Add the appropriate amount of detergent to the main wash compartment and fabric softener to its designated compartment. Close the drawer gently.

4.4 Selecting a Wash Program

Turn the program selector knob or press the program buttons to choose one of the 14 available wash programs suitable for your laundry type (e.g., Cotton, Synthetics, Delicates, Quick Wash).

4.5 Adjusting Settings

After selecting a program, you can adjust additional settings such as water temperature, spin speed, or add an extra rinse cycle using the corresponding buttons on the control panel.

4.6 Starting a Cycle

Press the 'Start/Pause' button to begin the selected wash cycle. The machine will automatically fill with water and start washing.

4.7 Pausing/Canceling a Cycle

To pause a cycle, press the 'Start/Pause' button. To cancel a cycle, press and hold the 'Start/Pause' button for a few

seconds, or turn the machine off and then on again to select a new program.

4.8 End of Cycle

The machine will signal the end of the cycle. Wait for the door lock to release before opening the door and removing your laundry.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Detergent Dispenser

Regularly remove and clean the detergent dispenser drawer to prevent residue buildup. Rinse it under running water and reinsert it.

5.2 Cleaning the Drum

Run a 'Drum Clean' or 'Hot Wash' cycle with no laundry and a descaling agent or white vinegar periodically to remove detergent residue and odors.

5.3 Cleaning the Door Seal

Wipe the rubber door seal after each wash to remove lint, hair, and moisture, preventing mold and mildew growth.

5.4 Cleaning the Drain Pump Filter

Locate the drain pump filter (usually at the bottom front of the machine). Open the cover, drain any residual water, and carefully remove and clean the filter of any debris. Reinstall securely.

5.5 Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the machine with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following table before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	Power cord unplugged; Door not closed properly; Program not selected; 'Start/Pause' not pressed.	Check power connection; Ensure door is latched; Select a program; Press 'Start/Pause'.
No water filling	Water tap closed; Water inlet hose kinked or blocked; Water pressure too low.	Open water tap; Straighten hose; Check household water pressure.
Excessive vibration/noise	Transit bolts not removed; Machine not level; Uneven load.	Remove transit bolts; Adjust leveling feet; Redistribute laundry evenly.
Water leaks	Inlet/drain hose loose; Detergent dispenser clogged; Drain pump filter loose.	Tighten hose connections; Clean dispenser; Secure drain pump filter.
Clothes not clean	Too much/too little detergent; Incorrect program selected; Overloading.	Use correct detergent amount; Select appropriate program; Reduce load size.

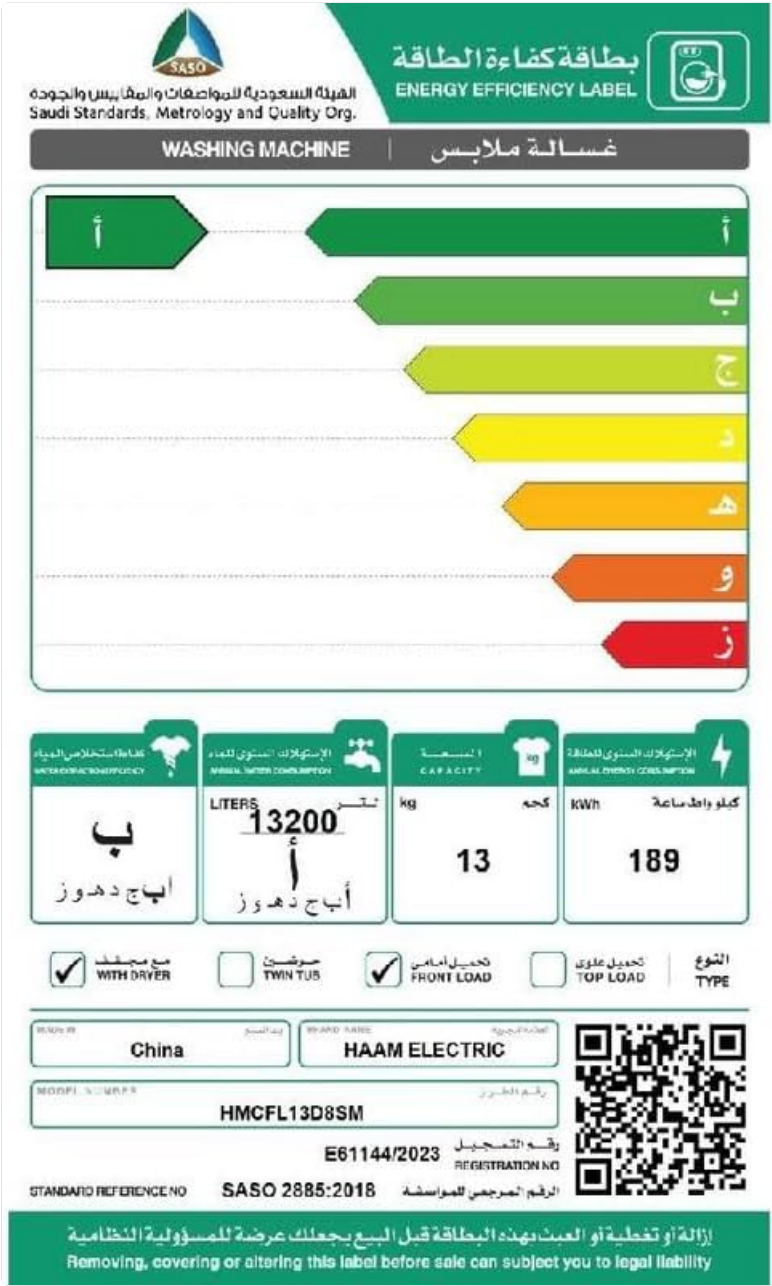


Image: Energy Efficiency Label for the washing machine, detailing its energy consumption and performance ratings. For verification, visit sls.gov.sa.
