IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using your Westinghouse Heated Snuggle Throw Blanket. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Do not use with infants, children, incapacitated persons, or anyone insensitive to heat.
- Do not use if the blanket is wet.
- Never use pins or other metallic objects with this blanket.
- Do not use if the power cord or controller is damaged. Contact customer support for assistance.
- Ensure the blanket is not folded, bunched, or tucked in when in use to prevent overheating.
- Always unplug the blanket from the power outlet when not in use or before cleaning.
- This blanket is intended for household use only.
- Do not dry clean this product. Follow care instructions for washing.
- Keep the controller away from open windows or direct sunlight to prevent damage.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Westinghouse Heated Snuggle Throw Blanket is designed for comfort and warmth, featuring a unique wearable design with sleeves and a foot pocket. It offers adjustable heat and timer settings for personalized use.

Key Features:

- **Wearable Design:** Features long sleeves and a foot pocket for full body warmth and freedom of movement.
- **Material:** Constructed with 200 GSM ultra-warm Sherpa lining and 200 GSM soft Flannel fleece face for comfort.
- **Heating Levels:** 6 adjustable heat settings to suit individual preferences.
- **Timer Settings:** Programmable auto-off timer from 2 to 10 hours.
- **Safety:** ETL and FCC certified with overheat protection.
- **Easy Care:** Machine washable (detachable controller).

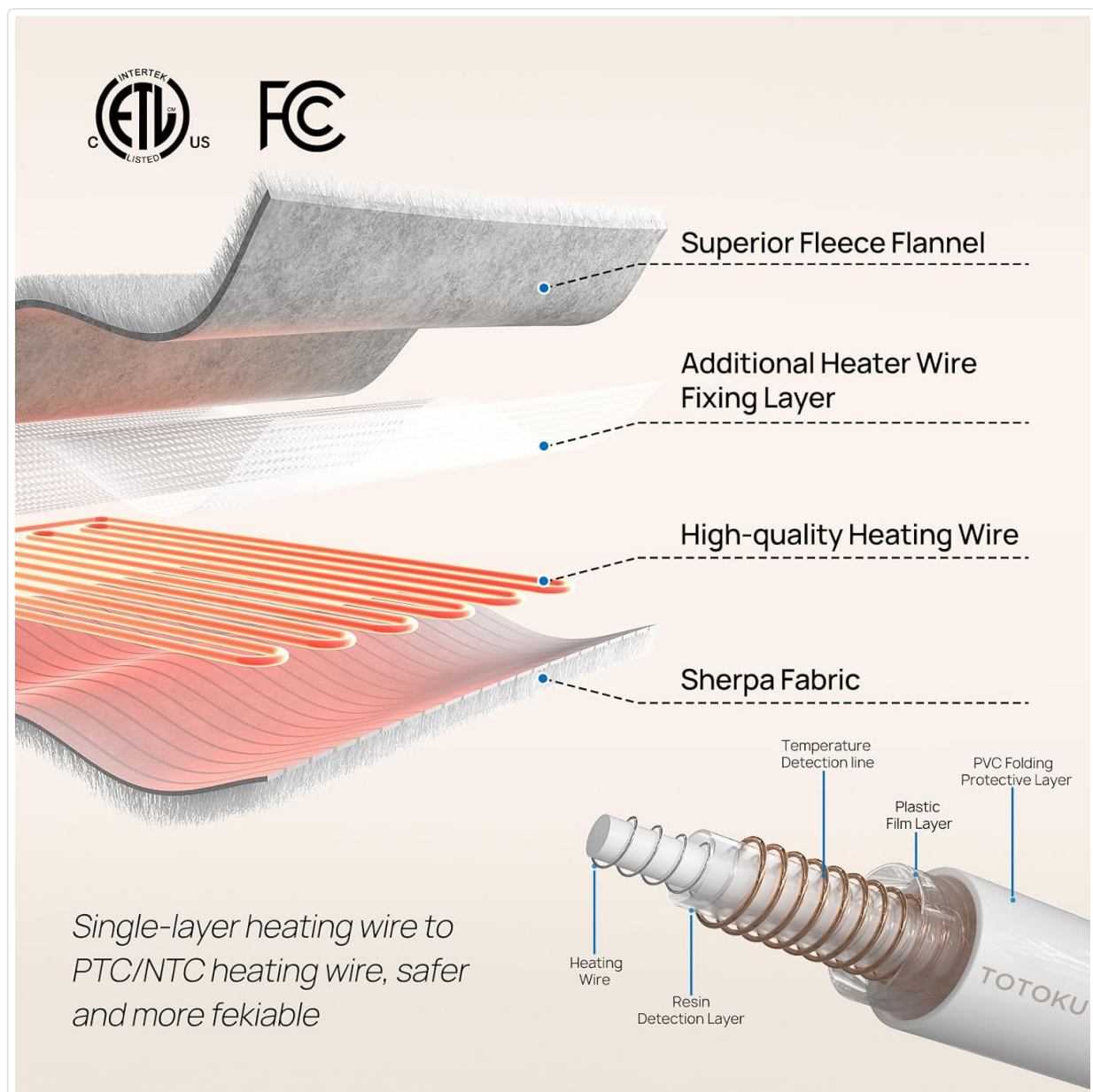


Figure 2: Cross-section diagram illustrating the multi-layered construction of the blanket, including superior fleece flannel, heater wire fixing layer, high-quality heating wire, and Sherpa fabric.

SETUP

1. **Unpack the Blanket:** Carefully remove the blanket from its packaging.
2. **Inspect for Damage:** Before first use, thoroughly inspect the blanket and controller for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Connect the Controller:** Locate the connector on the blanket and firmly plug the controller cord into it. Ensure a secure connection.
4. **Plug into Power:** Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC 60Hz wall outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button on the controller to turn the blanket on or off. The digital display will illuminate when on.
2. **Adjust Heat Settings:** Press the "HEAT" button to cycle through the 6 available heating levels. The current level will be displayed digitally.
3. **Set Timer:** Press the "TIME" button to select an auto-off duration. Options typically range from 2 to 10 hours. The selected time will be displayed.
4. **Wearing the Blanket:**
 - Slide your arms through the sleeves for freedom of movement.
 - Place your feet into the integrated foot pocket for additional warmth.
 - The blanket can be worn with the opening in the back or front, depending on preference.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and safe operation of your heated blanket.

1. **Disconnect Power:** Always unplug the controller from the blanket and the power cord from the wall outlet before cleaning.
2. **Machine Washing:**
 - Machine wash separately in cold water on a gentle cycle.
 - Do not use bleach.
 - Wash separately before first use.
3. **Drying:**
 - Tumble dry on low heat.
 - Do not iron.

- Do not dry clean.

4. **Storage:** Store the blanket in a cool, dry place when not in use. Ensure it is completely dry before storing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blanket does not heat.	Not properly plugged in; power outage; controller malfunction.	Ensure all connections are secure. Check power outlet. If issues persist, contact customer support.
Blanket heats unevenly.	Blanket is folded or bunched.	Lay the blanket flat and ensure it is not folded or bunched during use.
Controller display is off.	Blanket is off; power disconnected; timer expired.	Press the power button. Check power connections. If timer expired, restart the blanket.
