| Water is leaking from the tank. | Tank cap not securely closed;<br>Tank not properly seated; Crack in the tank. | Ensure the cap is tightly sealed. Re-seat the tank firmly until it clicks. Inspect for cracks; if found, replace the tank.    |
| No clean water is dispensed.    | Tank is empty; Outlet blocked;<br>Tank not properly installed.                | Refill the tank. Check the tank's outlet for debris and clean if necessary. Re-install the tank, ensuring it is fully seated. |
| Tank does not fit properly.     | Incorrect model; Obstruction in the slot.                                     | Verify that your vacuum cleaner is a Tineco 1.0 Floor One S3. Check the vacuum's tank slot for any foreign objects.           |
