INTRODUCTION

The Apple Watch Ultra 2 is a robust and advanced smartwatch designed for sports, adventure, and daily use. It features a rugged titanium case, a bright Always-On Retina display, precision dual-frequency GPS, and a customizable Action button. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

- Apple Watch Magnetic Fast Charger to USB-C Cable (1m)

SETUP

1. Charging Your Apple Watch

Before initial use, fully charge your Apple Watch Ultra 2. Connect the Magnetic Fast Charger to a USB-C power adapter (sold separately) and place the back of your watch on the magnetic charger.

2. Pairing with iPhone

1. Ensure your iPhone is updated to the latest iOS version and has Bluetooth enabled.
2. Turn on your Apple Watch by pressing and holding the side button until the Apple logo appears.

3. Bring your iPhone near your Apple Watch. A pairing screen will appear on your iPhone. Tap "Continue".
4. Position your iPhone so your Apple Watch appears in the viewfinder of the Apple Watch app.
5. Follow the on-screen instructions on both devices to complete the pairing process, including setting up cellular service if desired.

OPERATING YOUR APPLE WATCH ULTRA 2

Controls and Navigation

- **Digital Crown:** Rotate to scroll, zoom, or adjust values. Press once to go to the watch face or app list. Double-press to switch between recent apps. Press and hold for Siri.
- **Side Button:** Press once to open the Dock (recent apps). Press and hold for Emergency SOS or to power off. Double-press for Apple Pay.
- **Action Button:** Customizable button for quick access to features like Workout, Stopwatch, Waypoint, Backtrack, Dive, or Flashlight.
- **Touch Display:** Tap to select, swipe to navigate between screens, and press firmly (Force Touch) for additional options in some apps.

Key Features and Applications

- **Workout App:** Track various activities including running, cycling, swimming, and more. Features advanced metrics like Heart Rate Zones, custom workouts, and training load.
- **Precision Dual-Frequency GPS:** Provides highly accurate location data for outdoor activities.
- **Compass App:** Offers essential navigation tools including current heading, elevation, longitude, latitude, and the ability to set Waypoints and use Backtrack.
- **Oceanic+ App:** Functions as a full dive computer, sensing depth up to 40 meters and water temperature. Certified EN13319.
- **Health Monitoring:** Take an ECG, receive notifications for irregular heart rhythm, track sleep, and get alerts for potential sleep apnea.
- **Safety Features:** Automatic detection for hard falls and severe car crashes, connecting to emergency services. Emergency SOS and a loud siren are also available.
- **Cellular Connectivity:** With a cellular plan, make calls, send texts, stream music, and get directions without your iPhone nearby.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Apple Watch

- Turn off your Apple Watch and disconnect it from the charger.
- Wipe the watch with a non-abrasive, lint-free cloth. If necessary, lightly dampen the cloth with fresh water.
- For the Digital Crown, rotate it while running it under warm, fresh water for 10-15 seconds.
- Dry the watch thoroughly with a soft, lint-free cloth.

Battery Care

The Apple Watch Ultra 2 offers up to 36 hours of battery life under normal use and up to 72 hours in Low Power Mode. To optimize battery longevity, avoid extreme temperatures and keep the software updated.

Software Updates

Regularly update your Apple Watch to the latest watchOS version for new features, performance improvements, and security updates. Updates can be managed through the Apple Watch app on your iPhone.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch not turning on:** Ensure it is charged. Connect to the charger for at least 30 minutes.
- **Pairing issues:** Ensure Bluetooth is on, both devices are restarted, and the Apple Watch app is open on your iPhone.
- **Poor battery life:** Check for background app refresh, disable unnecessary notifications, and ensure watchOS is up to date. Consider using Low Power Mode.
- **Apps not responding:** Force quit the app by holding the side button until the power off slider appears, then press the Digital Crown.
- **Water Ejection:** After swimming or diving, rotate the Digital Crown to eject water from the speaker.
