

Safety Information



Setup

1. Battery Charging

Before initial use, fully charge the battery. The clippers come with two batteries, providing up to 4 hours of continuous operation, sufficient for grooming multiple horses.

Lasts Up to 4 Hours
Enough to shave 3-4 horses for a full body

2. Blade Assembly and Disassembly

The clippers feature detachable high-strength carbon steel blades for easy cleaning and replacement. Follow these steps to change or clean the blades:

- Disassembly:** Loosen the knob on the clipper head. Use the provided screwdriver to remove the screws securing the blade. Carefully remove the blade.
- Assembly:** Place the new blade onto the clipper head, aligning the holes. Insert the screws and tighten them with the screwdriver. Finally, tighten the knob to secure the blade. Ensure the blade is firmly attached before use.

Operating Instructions

Follow these steps for effective and safe grooming:

- 1. Preparation:** Ensure the horse's coat is clean, dry, and free of debris or tangles.
- 2. Power On:** Turn on the clippers using the one-button switch.
- 3. Clipping:** Move the clippers against the direction of hair growth for an even cut. The high-speed motor (2400 RPM) and carbon steel blade are designed to cut through thick coats efficiently.
- 4. Comfort:** The ergonomic design minimizes hand fatigue during extended use. Multiple ventilation holes help dissipate heat, preventing overheating and extending battery life.





Maintenance

Proper maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your clippers.

- Cleaning:** After each use, clean the blades and clipper head with the provided cleaning brush to remove hair and debris.
- Lubrication:** To ensure smooth operation and prevent overheating, it is recommended to apply lubricating oil to the blades every 10 minutes during use.
- Storage:** Store the clippers and accessories in the provided packing box in a dry, safe place.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your oneisall Cordless Horse Clippers, refer to the following common solutions:

- Clippers Not Turning On:** Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted. Check the power switch for proper engagement.
- Blades Not Cutting Effectively:** Clean the blades thoroughly to remove any lodged hair. Apply lubricating oil. Ensure the blades are correctly assembled and tightened. If blades are dull, replace them with a new set.
- Overheating:** If the clippers become warm, stop use and allow them to cool. Ensure the blades are clean and well-lubricated. The clippers are designed with multi-hole heat dissipation, but continuous heavy use without lubrication can lead to heat buildup.
- Excessive Noise/Vibration:** Check that the blades are securely fastened and properly aligned. Lubricate the blades.




