1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the safe and effective use of your Direct Store Parts DS126 Stainless Steel BBQ Cooking Griddle. This universal flat top griddle is designed for use with most gas grills, offering a versatile cooking surface for various food items.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always use heat-resistant gloves when handling the hot griddle.
- Ensure the griddle is stable on your grill grates before cooking.
- Do not leave the griddle unattended while in use.
- Keep children and pets away from the hot cooking surface.
- Allow the griddle to cool completely before cleaning or storing.
- Use appropriate tools for cooking on a griddle, such as spatulas and tongs.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the griddle for any signs of damage. If any damage is found, do not use the product and contact customer support.

3.2 Attaching Handles

The griddle comes with two handles for easy transport. Attach the handles to the designated holes on the sides of the griddle using the provided screws and nuts. Ensure they are securely fastened.

3.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, wash the griddle thoroughly with warm soapy water. Rinse completely and dry immediately to prevent water spots. A light coating of cooking oil can be applied to the surface after drying to season it.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Placement on Grill

Place the griddle directly on the grates of your gas grill. Ensure it is centered and stable. The griddle is designed to fit most gas grills, providing approximately 225 square inches of cooking surface.

4.2 Preheating

Turn on your gas grill to a medium-low heat setting. Allow the griddle to preheat for 5-10 minutes. A few drops of water should sizzle and evaporate quickly when the griddle is hot enough.

4.3 Cooking

Apply a thin layer of cooking oil to the griddle surface before placing food. The flat, smooth surface is suitable for cooking a variety of foods such as pancakes, bacon, eggs, sandwiches, chicken, burgers, sausages, and vegetables.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning After Use

Allow the griddle to cool down. Scrape off any excess food residue with a griddle scraper. For thorough cleaning, soak the griddle in hot water with detergent for a few minutes, then wash with a brush or sponge. The smooth, non-stick surface facilitates easy cleaning.

5.2 Storage

After cleaning and drying, store the griddle in a dry place to prevent rust or corrosion. A light coating of cooking oil can help protect the surface during storage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Food Sticking

Ensure the griddle is properly preheated and a sufficient amount of cooking oil is applied before adding food. Regular seasoning of the griddle surface can also improve non-stick properties.

6.2 Uneven Heating

Check that your gas grill burners are functioning correctly and providing even heat distribution. The griddle's heavy-duty stainless steel construction is designed for even heat, but external heat sources can vary.
