INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for identifying, ordering, and using your EasyKeys BB03 replacement key for Kobalt truck toolboxes. It also covers compatibility with other manufacturers and general key care.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The EasyKeys BB03 is a custom-cut replacement key designed for truck toolboxes. It is compatible with the Kobalt BB01 - BB50 key series and various other manufacturers.

- **Key Code:** BB03
- **Compatibility:** Kobalt (BB01-BB50 series), Bauer, Better Built, Eberhard, Northern Tool, Husky, Tractor Supply (GCODE / CODES ONLINE)
- **Key Type:** Double-sided cut key
- **Key Blank:** 1676
- **Material:** Brass

IDENTIFYING YOUR LOCK CODE (SETUP)

Before ordering a replacement key, it is crucial to accurately identify the lock code for your truck toolbox. The BB03 key is specific to the BB03 code. Incorrect codes will result in an incompatible key.

Common Locations for Lock Codes:

1. **On the Original Key:** If you have an existing key, the code is often stamped directly on the key head.
2. **On the Lock Face:** The code may be engraved or printed on the visible part of the lock cylinder.
3. **Inside/Behind the Lock:** For some toolboxes, the code might be on a label or stamped on the lock mechanism itself, requiring you to open the toolbox or access the lock from the inside.
4. **On a Cabinet/Door Label:** Less common for toolboxes, but some manufacturers place codes on labels inside the compartment or on the door.

Important Notes

- Order by Manufacturer → Lock codes are manufacturer-specific.
- Key Cuts Differ → Even if codes look similar, they vary by brand.

Important Notes:

- Always order by manufacturer and lock code. Lock codes are manufacturer-specific.
- Key cuts differ between brands. Even if codes appear similar, the actual key cuts can vary significantly by manufacturer.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To use your EasyKeys BB03 replacement key:

1. **Insert the Key:** Gently insert the BB03 key into the lock cylinder of your compatible truck toolbox. Do not force the key.
2. **Turn to Unlock:** Turn the key clockwise or counter-clockwise, depending on your lock mechanism, to unlock the toolbox.
3. **Remove the Key:** Once unlocked, turn the key back to its original position and carefully remove it.

Ensure the key is fully inserted before attempting to turn it. If the key does not turn smoothly, do not apply excessive force, as this may damage the key or the lock.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance can extend the life of your key and lock:

- **Keep Clean:** Periodically wipe the key with a dry cloth to remove dirt or debris.
- **Lubrication (Optional):** If the lock mechanism becomes stiff, a small amount of graphite lubricant (not oil-based lubricants) can be applied to the key or directly into the lock cylinder. Consult your toolbox manufacturer's guidelines for lock maintenance.
- **Storage:** Store spare keys in a safe, dry place to prevent loss or damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Key Does Not Insert Fully:**
Check for obstructions in the lock cylinder. Ensure the key is oriented correctly. If the key is bent or damaged, it may need replacement.
- **Key Inserts but Does Not Turn:**
Verify that the key code (BB03) matches the code on your lock. The lock mechanism might be jammed or corroded. Try applying a small amount of graphite lubricant. If the issue persists, the lock itself may require professional attention.
- **Key Feels Loose or Wobbly:**
This could indicate wear on the key or the lock cylinder. If the key is worn, it may need replacement. If the lock is worn, it might require repair or replacement.
