

- 1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the foot massager and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the massager on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is enough space around the unit for comfortable use and proper ventilation. It can be used on the floor or under a desk.
- 3. **Power Connection:** Connect the power adapter to the massager's power input port. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet (AC100V-240V, 50-60Hz).
- 4. **Remote Control Batteries:** The remote control requires two (2) 1.5V AAA batteries (not included). Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote and insert the batteries, observing the correct polarity (+/-). Close the compartment securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Bluestone Foot Massager can be operated using either the touch panel on the unit or the wireless remote control.

Getting Started:

- 1. Sit comfortably in a chair and place your feet on the footpads of the massager. Ensure your feet are centered on the acupressure nodes.
- 2. Press the **Power button** on the touch panel or remote control to turn on the unit. The display will illuminate.

Using the Touch Panel:

- Power: Press to turn the unit On/Off.
- Mode: Cycle through different massage modes (Vibration only, Massage only, Both Vibration and Massage).
- Intensity/Speed: Use the '+' and '-' buttons to adjust the intensity level (20 levels available) or the speed of the rotating acupressure.
- **Program (P):** Select from pre-set auto-programs (P1-P5) for varied massage routines.

Using the Remote Control:

The remote control offers full functionality for convenience.

- Power (Red Button): Turns the unit On/Off.
- Mode (Square/Play Button): Toggles between Vibration, Massage, or Both.
- High/Mid/Low: Adjusts the overall intensity level.
- **Speed** (+/-): Increases or decreases the speed of the rotating acupressure.
- Time (+/-): Adjusts the massage duration (though the unit has a default 10-minute cycle).
- P1-P5: Directly select one of the five pre-programmed massage routines.

Automatic Shut-off:

The massager is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature and will turn off after completing a 10-minute cycle to prevent overheating and ensure user safety.



MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life of your Bluestone Foot Massager.

- Cleaning: Always unplug the massager before cleaning. Wipe the surface of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or submerge the unit in water.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the massager in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and excessive heat. Keep it out of reach of children and pets.
- Cord Care: Do not wrap the power cord tightly around the unit. Avoid twisting or kinking the cord.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Bluestone Foot Massager, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in; Power outlet issue; Damaged power cord; Remote batteries dead/incorrectly inserted.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged into unit and outlet. Test outlet with another device. Check power cord for damage. Replace remote batteries and ensure correct polarity.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No vibration/massage.	Incorrect mode selected; Intensity set too low.	Press the 'Mode' button to cycle through modes (Vibration, Massage, Both). Increase intensity using '+' button.
Remote control not working.	Dead batteries; Obstruction between remote and unit; Remote too far from unit.	Replace batteries. Ensure clear line of sight to the unit's sensor. Move closer to the unit.
Unit turns off unexpectedly.	Automatic 10-minute cycle completed; Overheating.	This is normal operation after 10 minutes. If it turns off frequently before 10 minutes, unplug and let it cool down for 30 minutes before restarting.




Image: Diagram showing the dimensions of the Bluestone Foot Massager: 15.3 inches in length, 15.7 inches in width, and 5 inches in


