## 1. INTRODUCTION

The BRINKS Portable Security Door Lock is designed to provide additional security and peace of mind for inward-opening doors. This device is ideal for use in homes, dorm rooms, apartments, hotels, and short-term rentals, offering an extra layer of protection against unauthorized entry. Its compact and lightweight design makes it convenient for travel.

## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- Easy Installation:** No tools are required for installing this portable door lock.
- Versatile Design:** Features dual ends to fit most door strike plates, accommodating both standard residential doors and larger deadbolts commonly found in hotels.
- Strong and Durable:** Constructed from high-quality metal and plastic materials for reliable security.
- Compact and Lightweight:** Measures approximately 5 x 2.5 x 0.5 inches, making it suitable for travel and easy to carry.
- Tamper-Proof Security:** Designed to prevent unauthorized access, making it difficult to break or tamper with.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 1 x BRINKS Portable Security Door Lock (metal plate with blue plastic shield and chain)

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to install your BRINKS Portable Security Door Lock:

- 1. Choose the Correct End:** The portable door lock features two different-sized ends on the metal plate. Select the end that best fits the strike plate of your door. The smaller hole is for standard residential doors, while the larger opening is designed for bigger deadbolts, often found in hotels.
- 2. Insert into Strike Plate:** With the door open, insert the chosen end of the metal plate into the door's strike plate (the metal plate on the door frame where the latch enters). Ensure it is securely seated.
- 3. Close the Door:** Gently close the door, making sure the metal plate remains in position within the strike plate. The door should close as much as possible without obstruction.
- 4. Secure the Blue Shield:** Take the blue plastic shield, which is attached to the metal plate by a chain. Locate the heart-shaped slot on the metal plate closest to the door. Insert the circular metal slider on the back of the blue shield into this slot. Push it down firmly to secure it in place. Ensure the 'B' logo on the blue shield faces the doorknob.

Insert Portable Door Lock into the door strike plate.

Close the door.



3

Insert the Brinks Shield into the Heart-Shaped slot closest to the door.

Make sure the Brinks Shield is facing the doorknob.




Figure 4.2: The dual-ended design of the metal plate, showing a smaller hole for standard residential doors and a larger opening for bigger deadbolts.
