# Beetel G20 Landline Phone User Manual

Comprehensive guide for your Beetel G20 Caller ID Phone.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Beetel G20 is a TEC Certified landline phone designed for reliable communication. It features a clear LCD display with adjustable contrast, caller ID functionality, and various user-friendly options for enhanced convenience.

## SETUP GUIDE

---

### 1. Unpacking and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect the phone and accessories for any signs of damage. Retain the packaging for future transport or service needs.

### 2. Connecting the Phone

1. **Connect the Handset:** Plug one end of the coiled cord into the handset and the other end into the jack labeled **"HANDSET"** on the side of the phone base.
2. **Connect to Telephone Line:** Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the jack labeled **"LINE"** on the back of the phone base. Plug the other end into your wall telephone jack.
3. **Power Connection:** The Beetel G20 is corded electric and does not require external power adapter or batteries for basic operation. It draws power directly from the telephone line.

### 3. Desk or Wall Mounting

The Beitel G20 is designed for both desk and wall mounting. For wall mounting, use the integrated wall mount holes on the base of the phone and secure it to a wall using appropriate screws (not included).

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Making and Receiving Calls

- **To Make a Call:** Lift the handset, wait for a dial tone, and dial the desired number.
- **To Receive a Call:** When the phone rings, lift the handset to answer.
- **Ending a Call:** Place the handset back on the cradle.

### LCD Display and Contrast Adjustment

The phone features a Liquid Crystal Display (LCD) that shows caller ID information, date, and time. You can adjust the contrast for optimal visibility.

- **Adjusting Contrast:** Use the dedicated buttons (often labeled "UP" or "DOWN" near the display) to cycle through the 3 levels of LCD contrast.

### Caller ID Functionality (DTMF/FSK Compatible)

The G20 supports both DTMF (Dual-Tone Multi-Frequency) and FSK (Frequency Shift Keying) caller ID systems, ensuring compatibility with various telephone networks. Incoming call information (number, date, time) will be displayed on the LCD screen.

## Adjustable Handset and Ringer Volume

Customize your call experience by adjusting the volume levels.

- **Handset Volume:** Use the **"VOL/UP"** and **"VOL/DOWN"** buttons during a call to adjust the handset listening volume.
- **Ringer Volume:** The ringer volume can be adjusted using a switch on the side or bottom of the phone, or via menu settings if available. Refer to the on-screen prompts or physical indicators.

## Music on Hold

The Music on Hold feature allows you to play music for callers when they are placed on hold. This is typically activated by pressing the **"HOLD"** button during an active call.

## Ringer LED Indicator

The phone includes an LED indicator that illuminates when there is an incoming call or message, providing a visual alert in addition to the audible ring.

## Mute Function

The mute function allows you to temporarily disable your microphone during a call, so the other party cannot hear you. This is typically a toggle function activated by a **"MUTE"** button.

## Programmable Flash Time

The flash time (the duration of a hook-flash signal) can be programmed to ensure compatibility with different PBX systems or network services. The default setting is 300ms.

## Do Not Disturb Function

Activate the Do Not Disturb (DND) function to temporarily silence incoming calls. This feature is useful when you do not wish to be interrupted.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the phone's surface. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the phone in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Cord Care:** Avoid tangling or stretching the coiled handset cord and the telephone line cord to prevent damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No dial tone	Telephone line cord is disconnected or faulty.	Check all cable connections. Ensure the telephone line cord is securely plugged into the wall jack and the phone. Test with another phone if possible.
No display on LCD	No incoming line power or display settings.	Ensure the phone is properly connected to the telephone line. Adjust LCD contrast settings.
Cannot hear caller / Caller cannot hear me	Handset volume too low or mute function activated.	Adjust handset volume using the VOL/UP/DOWN buttons. Check if the MUTE button is active. Ensure handset cord is securely connected.
Ringer not working	Ringer volume set to minimum or ringer disabled.	Check the ringer volume switch/setting. Ensure Do Not Disturb (DND) function is not active.
