Initial Cleaning

Before first use, thoroughly wash both bottles and their caps with warm soapy water. Rinse completely to remove any manufacturing residues. The bottles are dishwasher safe for convenience.

Installation on Bicycle

The ZEFAL Arctica 75 bottles are designed to fit standard bicycle bottle cages. Ensure your bottle cage is securely mounted to your bicycle frame. Insert the bottle firmly into the cage. For optimal stability, ensure the bottle is fully seated.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Filling the Bottle

Unscrew the cap and fill the bottle with your desired beverage. Do not overfill; leave a small air gap at the top. For best insulation performance with cold drinks, pre-chill the bottle with cold water before filling. For hot drinks, pre-warm the bottle with hot water. The maximum temperature for hot liquids is 80 °C (176 °F).

Using the Cap and Valve

The cap features a pull-out valve for drinking. Pull the valve upwards to open it and push it down to close. Ensure the valve is fully closed when not drinking to prevent leaks and maintain insulation. The screw-on cap should be tightened securely to prevent spills.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Regular cleaning is essential to maintain hygiene and prevent odors. The bottles and caps are dishwasher safe. For hand washing, use a bottle brush with warm soapy water to clean the interior. Pay attention to the valve area, ensuring no residue builds up. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning.

Storage

When not in use, store the bottles clean and dry. It is recommended to store them with the caps slightly open or removed to allow for air circulation and prevent moisture buildup, which can lead to odors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Liquid not staying cold/hot:** Ensure the cap is tightly screwed on and the valve is fully closed. Pre-chilling or pre-warming the bottle before filling can significantly improve temperature retention.
- **Unpleasant odor or taste:** This usually indicates insufficient cleaning. Disassemble the cap components if possible and clean all parts thoroughly with warm soapy water. A mixture of baking soda and water can help neutralize persistent odors. Rinse extensively.
- **Leaking:** Check that the cap is screwed on straight and tightly. Ensure the drinking valve is fully pushed down to the closed position. Inspect the silicone seal (if present) for damage or misalignment.
