INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Sharper Image Mecha Rivals Remote Control Ejecting Battle Robots. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper function and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

- May contain small parts not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended during play.
- Do not operate robots near stairs, furniture, or other obstacles to prevent damage or injury.
- Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Remove batteries from robots and remote controls when not in use for extended periods.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Ensure all items are present before beginning setup:

- 1x Blue Battle Robot (Jib)
- 1x White Battle Robot (Jab)
- 1x Blue Remote Control (for Jib)
- 1x White Remote Control (for Jab)
- 2x Ejecting Pilot Figures

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

Batteries required (not included): Refer to the product packaging for specific battery requirements for each robot and remote control unit. Typically, each robot and remote control requires AA batteries.

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of each robot and on the back of each remote control.
2. Using a small screwdriver (not included), open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and secure it with the screw.

2. Pilot Installation

Place the small pilot figures into the designated ejector seats on top of each robot. Ensure they are seated securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Powering On

Turn on each robot and its corresponding remote control using the ON/OFF switches. The robots and remotes will automatically pair via infrared technology.

2. Basic Controls (Refer to Remote Control Layout)

- **Left Joystick:** Controls forward and backward movement.
- **Right Joystick:** Controls turning left and right.
- **Left Punch Button:** Initiates a left arm punch.
- **Right Punch Button:** Initiates a right arm punch.

3. Battle Modes

The Mecha Rivals offer two primary modes of play:

- **Versus Mode (Two Players):** Each player controls one robot. The objective is to hit the opponent's chest plate twice. The first robot to have its pilot ejected twice loses the round.
- **Solo Mode (Single Player):** Practice your skills against the AI-controlled robot.

4. Winning a Battle

To win a battle, successfully land two punches on your opponent's chest plate. Each successful hit will trigger lights and sounds, and the second hit will cause the opponent's pilot to eject, signifying victory.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe robots and remote controls with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use water or cleaning solutions.
- **Storage:** Store the robots and remote controls in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use. Remove batteries for long-term storage.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when performance diminishes.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Robot not responding to remote.	<p>Ensure both robot and remote are powered ON.</p> <p>Check battery levels in both robot and remote; replace if low.</p> <p>Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and robot's infrared sensors.</p> <p>Try re-pairing by turning both devices off and then on again.</p>

Problem	Solution
Robot moves slowly or erratically.	Replace batteries in the robot. Ensure the play surface is smooth and clear of debris.
Pilot not ejecting after hits.	Ensure the pilot figure is correctly seated in the ejector seat. Verify that the hits are directly on the chest plate target. Check battery levels.
