1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the setup, operation, and basic maintenance of your Generic Replacement Remote Control. This remote is designed to function with various JVC Micro Component Stereo Systems. Please review this manual carefully before use.

Important: This replacement remote is intended to mimic the functions of your original remote. Due to the generic nature, not all functions may be identical or fully supported. It is crucial to compare the appearance of this remote with your original unit to ensure compatibility before use. If your original remote differs significantly in appearance, this replacement may not be suitable.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the layout and buttons of your new replacement remote control.

3. SETUP: BATTERY INSTALLATION

To begin using your replacement remote control, you must first install the batteries.

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or press the latch (if present) and lift to open.
3. Insert **two (2) CR2 batteries** into the compartment, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the indicators inside the compartment.
4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

The remote control is now ready for use. No programming is typically required for this infrared (IR) replacement remote.

4. OPERATION

This replacement remote control operates via infrared (IR) signals. Point the remote directly at the IR receiver on your JVC Micro Component Stereo System for optimal performance.

4.1. Compatible JVC Models

This remote is designed to be compatible with the following JVC Micro Component Stereo System models:

- UX-SG6VB
- UX-SG6VBS
- UX-L5VA
- CA-UXSG6VB
- CA-UXL5V
- RM-SUXF5VBR
- UX-F5V
- UX-SG7V

4.2. Basic Functions

The remote provides standard controls for your stereo system, including:

- **Power On/Off:** Use the **O/I** button.
- **Input Selection:** Buttons like **DVD/CD**, **USB**, **iPod A**, **iPod B** allow you to switch audio sources.
- **Volume Control:** Use the **VOLUME +/-** buttons.
- **Navigation:** The central directional pad (**UP**, **DOWN**, **LEFT**, **RIGHT**) and **ENTER/SET** button are used for menu navigation.
- **Playback Controls:** Standard buttons for **PLAY**, **PAUSE**, **STOP**, **FAST FORWARD**, **REWIND**, **SKIP** are available.
- **Numeric Keypad:** For direct track selection or input.

Refer to your JVC Micro Component Stereo System's original manual for detailed information on specific functions and menu operations.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your remote control.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the remote with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Do not use harsh chemicals or immerse the remote in liquid.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries promptly when the remote's performance degrades. Remove batteries if the remote will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage.
- **Storage:** Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Avoid Drops:** Protect the remote from physical impact, as drops can damage internal components.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your remote control, try the following steps:

1. **Check Batteries:** Ensure batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity (+/-). Replace old batteries with new CR2 batteries.
2. **Line of Sight:** Make sure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the IR receiver on your JVC stereo system. Point the remote directly at the system.
3. **Distance:** Ensure you are within the effective operating range of the remote control (typically up to 20 feet or 6 meters).
4. **Interference:** Strong light sources (like direct sunlight or certain fluorescent lights) can interfere with IR signals. Try operating the remote in a different lighting condition.
5. **Original Remote Comparison:** If certain functions do not work, verify that your original remote had those specific buttons or features. This generic replacement may not support all advanced or unique functions of every compatible model.
