OPERATING YOUR INVERSION TABLE

Height Adjustment

The Drumfit Inversion 1800 features 26 adjustable height levels to accommodate users between 147 cm and 198 cm. Proper height adjustment is crucial for safe and effective inversion.

- Locate the height adjustment pin on the main frame.
- Pull the pin out and slide the frame to the desired height setting.
- Ensure the pin fully re-engages into the corresponding hole to lock the height securely.

Using the Safety Belt and Pads

The inversion table is equipped with a safety belt and comfortable pads to provide secure support and comfort during your inversion sessions.

- Before inverting, position yourself on the backrest and secure the ankle supports firmly.
- Fasten the safety belt around your waist or chest as indicated in the assembly manual, ensuring it is snug but not overly tight.
- The padded backrest and ankle supports are designed for comfort; ensure they are properly aligned with your body.

Achieving Total Inversion
