

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Step 1: Prepare the Handlebar

Ensure your bicycle's handlebar is clean and free from any obstructions. Identify the optimal position for the mounting base, typically centered on the handlebar.

Step 2: Attach Cushioning Spacers

Place the EVA cushioning spacers on the handlebar where the mounting base will make contact. These spacers are crucial for preventing scratches and absorbing vibrations during your ride.

Step 3: Secure the Mounting Base to the Handlebar

Position the Rhinowalk Y9401B mounting base on the handlebar, aligning it with the cushioning spacers. Use the provided straps to secure the top buckles around the handlebar. Ensure the straps are tightened firmly to prevent movement.

Step 4: Secure to Head Tube/Stem

For additional stability and to prevent swinging, use the lower strap to secure the base around the bicycle's head tube or stem. Adjust all straps to be snug but not overly tight, ensuring they do not interfere with braking or shifting mechanisms.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Attaching Your Bag or Gear

The Rhinowalk Y9401B is designed to accommodate various dry bags, sleeping bags, or other cylindrical gear. Place your item onto the mounting base, ensuring it is centered and balanced.

Securing Your Load

Use the adjustable straps on the mounting base to firmly secure your bag or gear. Thread the straps through the buckles and pull them tight. Ensure the load is balanced and does not obstruct your view, bicycle lights, or bike controls.

Weight Distribution

For optimal handling and safety, distribute the weight of your load evenly. Avoid overloading the handlebar, as excessive weight can negatively affect steering stability and control, especially at higher speeds or on rough terrain.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** To maintain the product's longevity, wipe the mounting base and straps with a damp cloth to remove dirt, mud, and debris after each use. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the material.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all straps, buckles, and the base itself for any signs of wear, fraying, cracks, or damage. Pay close attention to the stitching and connection points. Replace any worn or damaged components immediately to ensure safe operation.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the Rhinowalk Y9401B mounting base in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. This will help preserve the material and extend the product's lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue: Bag feels loose or shifts during riding.

Solution: Ensure all straps are tightened securely around both the handlebar and the bag. Re-adjust the cushioning spacers to provide a firm, non-slip grip on the handlebar. Verify that the load is not too heavy or improperly balanced, which can contribute to shifting.

Issue: Handlebar scratches or wear observed after use.

Solution: Confirm that the EVA cushioning spacers are correctly positioned between the mounting base and the handlebar, providing adequate protection. If the spacers appear worn or compressed, replace them to prevent further damage to your bike's finish.
