4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Meisiqi MT-025 Landline Phone:

1. **Connect the Telephone Line:** Locate the telephone line jack on the back or side of the phone. Insert one end of the provided telephone line cord into this jack.
2. **Connect to Wall Jack:** Insert the other end of the telephone line cord into your wall telephone jack.
3. **Place the Handset:** Place the handset securely on the phone base.
4. **Test Dial Tone:** Lift the handset. You should hear a clear dial tone, indicating the phone is ready for use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Making a Call

1. Lift the handset.
2. Listen for a dial tone.
3. Dial the desired phone number using the keypad.
4. Wait for the call to connect.
5. To end the call, replace the handset on the base.

5.2 Receiving a Call

1. When the phone rings, lift the handset to answer the call.
2. To end the call, replace the handset on the base.

5.3 LED Indicator

The phone features an LED indicator. This light typically illuminates to signal an incoming call or when the phone is in use.

5.4 Conference Call Capability

This model supports 5-way conference calls. Consult your telephone service provider for specific instructions on how to initiate and manage conference calls, as this feature is typically network-dependent.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No dial tone	Telephone line not connected properly.	Ensure the telephone line cord is securely plugged into both the phone and the wall jack.
Cannot make or receive calls	Service interruption from your provider.	Contact your telephone service provider to check for outages or issues with your line.
Poor call quality	Interference or faulty line.	Try connecting the phone to a different wall jack if available. Check for other electronic devices causing interference.
