INTRODUCTION

The Marantz Cinema 30 is an 11.4 channel 8K Home Theater Receiver designed to deliver a premium audio and video experience. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these safety instructions carefully before operating your Marantz Cinema 30 receiver. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Power Source:** Connect the unit only to an AC outlet of the voltage specified on the rear panel.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation. Do not block ventilation openings. Maintain a minimum distance of 10 cm (4 inches) from the rear and sides, and 20 cm (8 inches) from the top.
- **Water and Moisture:** Do not expose the unit to rain, moisture, dripping, or splashing. Do not place objects filled with liquids, such as vases, on the unit.
- **Heat:** Do not place the unit near heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- **Cleaning:** Unplug the unit from the wall outlet before cleaning. Use a dry cloth only.
- **Servicing:** Do not attempt to service this product yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

SETUP

Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove the receiver from its packaging. Place the unit on a stable, level surface with adequate ventilation. Avoid placing it in direct sunlight or near heat sources. Ensure there is sufficient space around the unit for proper airflow.

Connecting Your Speakers

The Cinema 30 supports up to an 11.4 channel configuration. Connect your speakers to the corresponding terminals on the rear panel. Ensure correct polarity (+ to + and - to -) for each speaker. For optimal performance, use high-quality speaker cables.

Connecting Video Sources (HDMI)

Connect your video sources (e.g., Blu-ray player, game console, streaming device) to the HDMI input ports on the rear panel. The Cinema 30 features 10 HDMI inputs, supporting 8K video passthrough. Connect your TV or projector to the HDMI OUT (MONITOR) port.

Connecting Audio Sources

In addition to HDMI, the receiver offers digital, analog, and phono inputs for various audio components. Connect your turntable to the PHONO input, or other audio devices to the analog or digital audio inputs as needed.

Network Connection

For network features, streaming, and firmware updates, connect the receiver to your home network via an Ethernet cable to the NETWORK port or wirelessly using the built-in Wi-Fi. Follow the on-screen instructions for Wi-Fi setup.

Initial Setup and Calibration

After connecting all components, power on the receiver and your display. The Setup Assistant will guide you through the initial configuration, including speaker detection, level adjustment, and room correction using the supplied Audyssey microphone. This process optimizes sound performance for your specific listening environment.

OPERATING

Basic Operation

Use the front panel controls or the remote control to power on/off the unit, adjust volume, and select input sources. The front display provides information on the current input, sound mode, and volume level.

The supplied remote control provides full functionality. For enhanced control and convenience, download the Marantz AVR Remote app on your smartphone or tablet. The app allows you to control inputs, volume, sound modes, and access network streaming features.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning and Care

To maintain the appearance and performance of your receiver, regularly wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical wipes, as these can damage the finish. Ensure the unit is unplugged before cleaning.

Firmware Updates

Marantz periodically releases firmware updates to improve performance, add features, and fix bugs. Connect your receiver to the internet to receive notifications for available updates. Follow the on-screen prompts to perform updates, ensuring the unit remains powered on throughout the process.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Marantz Cinema 30, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No power	Check power cord connection. Ensure the power outlet is functional.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No sound	Verify speaker connections. Check input source selection. Ensure volume is not muted or too low. Confirm correct audio output settings on source device.
No video	Check HDMI cable connections. Ensure correct input source is selected. Verify TV/projector input.
Remote control not working	Replace batteries. Ensure no obstructions between remote and receiver.
Network connection issues	Check Ethernet cable or Wi-Fi settings. Restart your router.
