1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Nanberone 4 Tier Mobile Tree Style Masking Paper Machine Station is a versatile and robust tool designed for efficient masking tasks in various applications, including auto body repair, home restoration, and general painting projects. This mobile station provides organized storage and easy dispensing of masking paper and tape rolls.

Key features include heavy-duty steel construction for durability, a mobile design with wheels and a handle for easy maneuverability, and multiple bars to accommodate various sizes of paper and tape. The integrated cutting blades ensure precise and clean cuts.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety warnings and instructions before operating this product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Sharp Blades:** The masking station is equipped with sharp cutting blades. Exercise extreme caution when handling or operating near the blades to prevent cuts. Keep hands clear of the cutting area during operation.
- **Stable Surface:** Ensure the masking station is placed on a stable, level surface before loading paper or tape,

and during operation, to prevent tipping.

- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity for paper and tape rolls. Overloading can compromise stability and damage the unit.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the masking station, especially during assembly and operation.
- **Proper Use:** Use this product only for its intended purpose of dispensing masking paper and tape.
- **Assembly:** Follow all assembly instructions carefully. Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened before use.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all components and verify that you have received all items listed below. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

- 4 Tier Tree Mobile Masking Station (Main Frame)
- Paper/Tape Dispensing Bars (4 sets)
- Cutting Blades (pre-installed on paper bars)
- Wheels (2)
- Handle (1)
- Assembly Hardware (nuts, bolts, washers, pins)
- Instruction Manual (this document)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required. Please follow these steps carefully.

1. **Unpack Components:** Lay out all parts on a clean, flat surface. Refer to the "What's in the Box" section to ensure all components are present.
2. **Attach Wheels:** Securely attach the two wheels to the designated axle points at the base of the main frame using the provided pins. Ensure the wheels spin freely.

3. **Install Dispensing Bars:** Insert the four sets of paper/tape dispensing bars into their respective slots on the main frame. The top two bars accommodate rolls up to 16 inches wide, and the bottom two bars accommodate rolls up to 21 inches wide. Secure them using the provided knobs and bolts.

4. **Attach Handle:** Secure the handle to the top of the main frame using the provided hardware.

- Adjust Washers:** The adjustable washers on each bar help keep your tape and paper rolls properly aligned. Adjust them as needed to fit the width of your rolls.

5. OPERATION

Using your Nanberone Masking Paper Machine Station is straightforward:

1. **Load Paper/Tape:** Place your desired masking paper or tape rolls onto the appropriate dispensing bars. Ensure the rolls are centered and secured by adjusting the washers.
2. **Pull Material:** Gently pull the masking paper or tape outwards from the roll.
3. **Cut Material:** Once the desired length is extended, press the paper or tape against the sharp, anodized cutting blade. Apply firm, even pressure to achieve a clean cut. Always exercise caution around the blades.
4. **Maneuver Station:** Use the handle and wheels to easily move the station to your work area as needed.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your masking station:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the frame and bars with a damp cloth to remove dust, paint, or adhesive residue. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.
- **Blade Inspection:** Periodically inspect the cutting blades for sharpness and damage. Dull blades can lead to uneven cuts. Replacement blades may be available from the manufacturer.
- **Hardware Check:** Regularly check all nuts, bolts, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain stability.
- **Wheel Maintenance:** Keep the wheels free of debris. If they become stiff, a small amount of lubricant can be applied to the axle.
- **Storage:** Store the masking station in a dry, clean environment when not in use to prevent rust and damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Paper/Tape not cutting cleanly.	Blades are dull or damaged. Insufficient pressure during cutting.	Inspect blades for damage; consider replacement if dull. Apply more firm, even pressure when cutting.
Rolls are not aligned or wobble.	Washers are not properly adjusted or tightened.	Adjust and tighten the black adjustment knobs and washers on the dispensing bars to secure the rolls.
Station is unstable or wobbly.	Loose assembly hardware. Uneven surface.	Check and tighten all nuts and bolts. Move the station to a flat, level surface.
Wheels are difficult to move.	Debris in wheels or axles.	Clear any debris from the wheels and axles. Apply a small amount of lubricant if necessary.
