1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always assemble the bar stools on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners.
- Do not stand on the bar stools.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 300 pounds per stool.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly.
- Use the bar stools on a level surface to prevent tipping.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

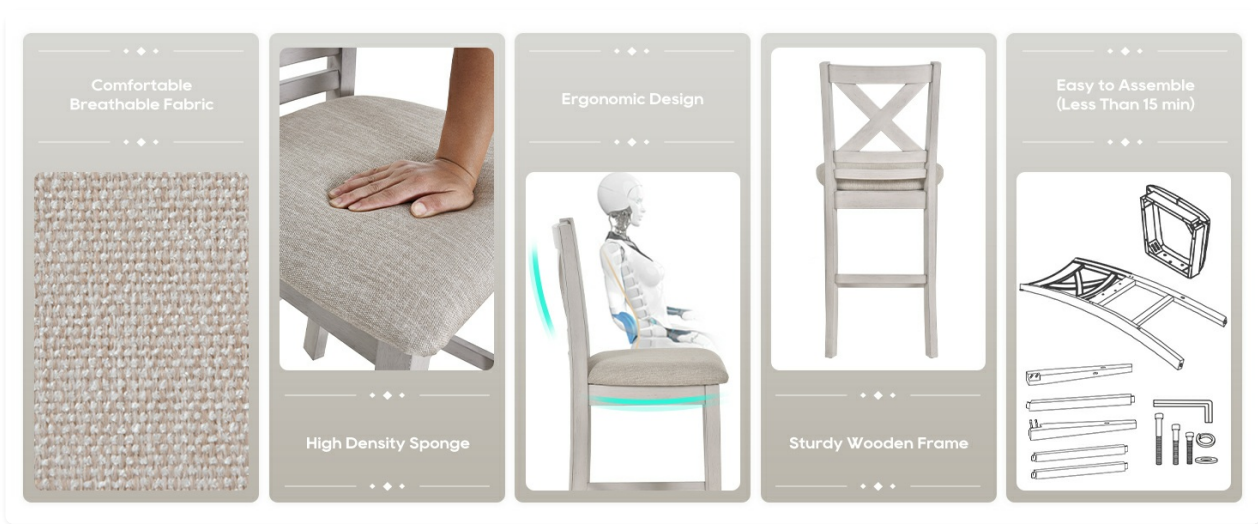


Image 3.1: Components for one bar stool. A set includes parts for two stools.

- Screw Bag (x1) - Contains all necessary hardware and tools.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for these bar stools. Please follow the steps below carefully. It is recommended to have two people for easier assembly.

Step-by-Step Assembly:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a soft, clean surface. Refer to Image 3.1 to identify all parts.
2. **Attach Legs to Seat Frame:** Secure the wooden legs to the underside of the seat frame using the provided bolts, washers, and Allen wrench from the screw bag. Ensure the legs are oriented correctly.
3. **Connect Crossbars:** Attach the crossbars between the legs using the wood screws and cross wrench. These provide stability and serve as footrests.
4. **Secure Backrest:** Attach the chair back frame to the assembled seat and leg structure. Use the appropriate screws and tighten them firmly.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once all parts are assembled, gently place the stool upright and re-tighten all screws and bolts to ensure maximum stability. Do not overtighten.

5. OPERATING AND USAGE

The COLAMY D1435 bar stools are designed for comfortable seating at counter height surfaces. Their versatile design makes them suitable for various settings.

- **Seating:** The 25.59-inch seat height is ideal for standard counter height tables (34-40 inches).
- **Comfort:** The upholstered fabric seat with high-density sponge and ergonomic backrest provide comfortable support.
- **Footrest:** Utilize the integrated footrest for added comfort and stability.
- **Placement:** Suitable for kitchen islands, dining rooms, home bars, coffee shops, and restaurants.

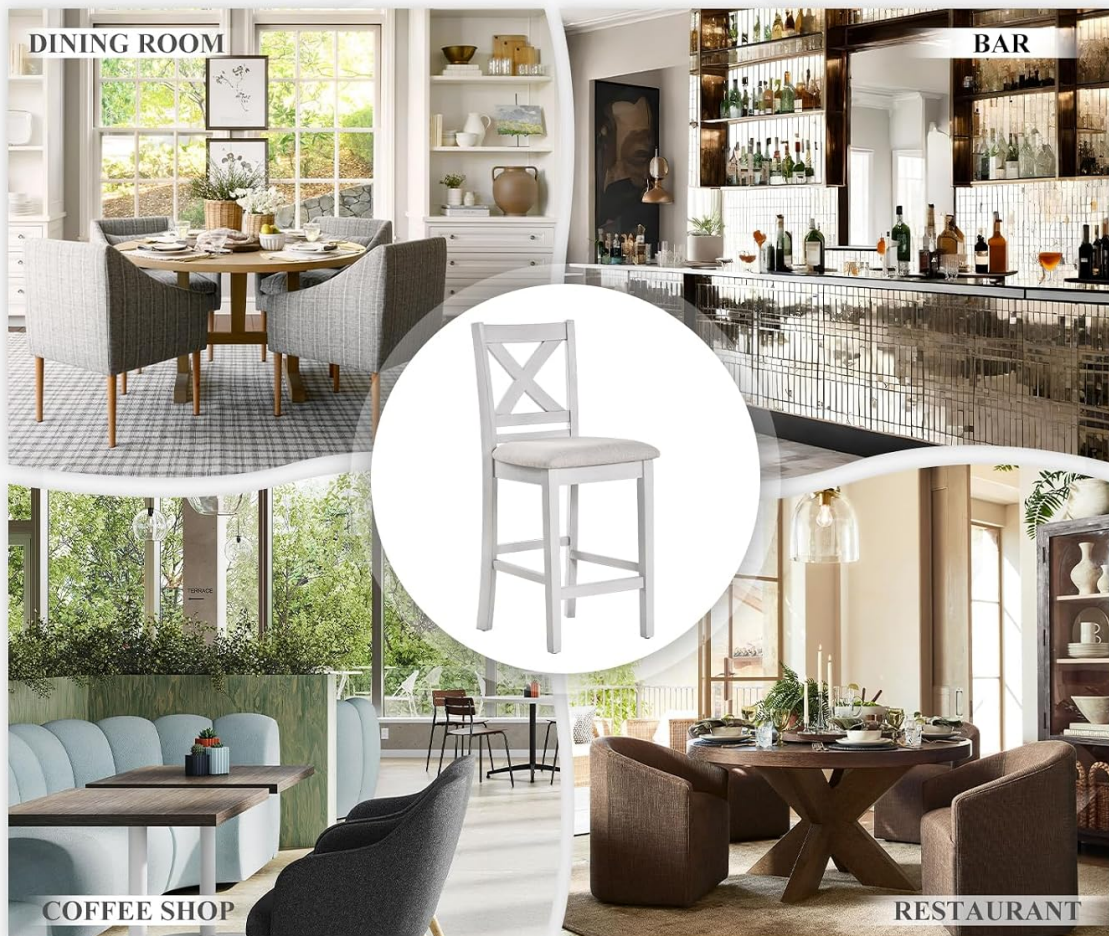


Image 5.1: Versatile use of COLAMY D1435 Bar Stools in different environments.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your COLAMY bar stools.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden frame with a dry cloth. For upholstered fabric, spot clean with a mild detergent and damp cloth as needed. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the wooden surfaces to prevent buildup.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all screws and bolts and re-tighten them if they become loose to maintain stability.
- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the fabric and wood finish.
- **Protect Floors:** The stools are equipped with anti-slip protectors on the feet. Ensure these are intact to prevent scratching floors.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bar stools, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Wobbling Stool:**

- Ensure all screws and bolts are fully tightened. Loosen all fasteners slightly, sit on the stool to level it, then re-tighten all fasteners evenly.
- Check if the floor surface is uneven. Use felt pads or shims if necessary.

- **Loose Parts:**

- Re-tighten any loose screws or bolts using the provided Allen wrench or cross wrench. Do not overtighten.

- **Squeaking:**

- Squeaking often indicates loose joints. Identify the source of the squeak and tighten the corresponding fasteners. A small amount of furniture wax or lubricant can be applied to joints if tightening does not resolve the issue.
