1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your CONTOURE DE-1350W RV Stackable Front-Load Electric Dryer. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference. Proper installation, use, and maintenance are crucial for optimal performance and longevity of the dryer.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons, read all instructions before using this appliance.

- Always follow local codes and ordinances for installation.
- Do not dry articles that have been previously cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with gasoline, dry-cleaning solvents, or other flammable or explosive substances.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance. Close supervision of children is necessary when the appliance is used near children.
- Before the appliance is removed from service or discarded, remove the door to the drying compartment.
- Do not reach into the appliance if the drum is moving.
- Do not install or store this appliance where it will be exposed to the weather.
- · Do not tamper with controls.
- Clean lint screen before or after each load.
- Do not use heat to dry articles containing foam rubber or similarly textured rubber-like materials.
- Keep area around the exhaust opening and adjacent surrounding areas free from the accumulation of lint, dust, and dirt.
- The interior of the appliance and exhaust duct should be cleaned periodically by qualified service personnel.
- Do not place items exposed to cooking oils in your dryer. Items contaminated with cooking oils may contribute to a chemical reaction that could cause a load to catch fire.
- Do not use this appliance for purposes other than its intended use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The CONTOURE DE-1350W is a compact, front-load electric dryer designed for space-saving applications such as RVs, boats, and tiny homes. It features user-friendly electronic controls, a digital display, and a durable stainless steel drum.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is critical for the safe and efficient operation of your dryer. It is recommended that installation be performed by a qualified technician.

4.1 Unpacking

• Carefully remove all packaging materials, including the base packaging.

- Inspect the dryer for any shipping damage. Report any damage to your retailer immediately.
- · Ensure all accessories are present.

4.2 Location Requirements

- The dryer must be installed on a firm, level floor capable of supporting its weight (76.5 lbs).
- Ensure adequate clearance around the dryer for proper ventilation and maintenance.
- Do not install the dryer in an area where it may be exposed to freezing temperatures.
- This dryer is designed for freestanding installation.

4.3 Electrical Requirements

- The dryer requires a dedicated 120 Volts (AC) electrical supply.
- Ensure the electrical outlet is properly grounded and meets all local electrical codes.

• Do not use extension cords with this appliance.

4.4 Venting Requirements

- The dryer must be properly vented to the outside to prevent lint and moisture buildup.
- Use rigid or flexible metal ducting for venting. Avoid plastic or foil ducting.
- Keep the vent duct as short and straight as possible to ensure efficient drying.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for optimal drying performance.

5.1 Loading the Dryer

- Sort laundry by fabric type and desired drying temperature.
- Do not overload the dryer. Clothes should tumble freely. The capacity is 13.2 pounds.
- Close the dryer door firmly. The door hinges are reversible for convenience.

5.2 Control Panel Overview

The control panel features electronic controls and a digital display for easy cycle and setting selection.

5.3 Selecting a Drying Cycle

Your dryer offers four drying cycles:

- Normal: For everyday cottons and mixed loads.
- Delicate: For delicate fabrics that require lower heat.
- Heavy Duty: For bulky items and heavy fabrics.
- Air Dry: No heat, for fluffing items or drying heat-sensitive materials.

Use the cycle selector button on the control panel to choose the desired cycle.

5.4 Selecting Temperature Settings

Three temperature settings are available:

• High: For sturdy fabrics like towels and jeans.

- Medium: For permanent press, synthetics, and light cottons.
- Low: For delicate items and heat-sensitive fabrics.

Press the temperature button to cycle through the available options.

5.5 Starting a Cycle

- After selecting the cycle and temperature, press the "Start/Pause" button to begin the drying cycle.
- The digital display will show the remaining drying time.

5.6 Child Lock Function

To activate the child lock, press and hold the designated lock button (refer to your control panel for specific icon) for a few seconds. This prevents accidental operation by children. Repeat the action to deactivate.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures efficient operation and extends the life of your dryer.

6.1 Cleaning the Lint Screen

- Clean the lint screen before or after every load. A clogged lint screen reduces drying efficiency and increases fire
 risk.
- Pull the lint screen out from its housing (usually located inside the door opening).
- Remove accumulated lint by hand. If necessary, wash the screen with warm, soapy water and a soft brush, then
 rinse thoroughly and dry completely before reinserting.

6.2 Cleaning the Dryer Interior

- · Wipe the dryer drum with a damp cloth and mild detergent if needed.
- For stubborn stains, a non-abrasive cleaner can be used, followed by a thorough wipe with a damp cloth to remove any residue.
- The interior of the appliance and exhaust duct should be cleaned periodically by qualified service personnel.

6.3 Cleaning the Exterior

- · Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before calling for service, review the following common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dryer does not start	Power cord unplugged Circuit breaker tripped/fuse blown Door not closed properly Child lock activated	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check household circuit breaker or fuse box. Close the door firmly until it latches. Deactivate child lock (refer to section 5.6).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clothes not drying properly	Clogged lint screen Overloaded dryer Incorrect cycle/temperature setting Restricted exhaust vent	Clean the lint screen (refer to section 6.1). Reduce load size. Select appropriate cycle and temperature for the fabric type. Check and clear the exhaust vent for obstructions.
Dryer is noisy	Foreign objects in drum Dryer not level	Check drum for loose items (coins, buttons, etc.). Ensure the dryer is installed on a level surface.


