## KEY FEATURES

## SETUP AND WEARING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Initial Inspection

Before each use, inspect your waders for any signs of damage, such as tears, punctures, or worn seams. Ensure all buckles and straps are securely attached and functional.

### 2. Donning the Waders

1. Step into the boots first, ensuring your feet are comfortably seated.
2. Pull the waders up over your legs and torso.
3. Place the shoulder straps over your shoulders.
4. Adjust the shoulder straps to achieve a snug but comfortable fit. The waders should not restrict movement or cause discomfort.
5. Fasten the waist belt and adjust it for a secure fit around your waist. This helps prevent water from entering if you stumble and provides additional support.

### 3. Converting to Waist-High

For warmer weather or shallower water, these waders can be converted to waist-high. Unclip the shoulder straps and use the reversible buckles to secure the upper portion of the waders around your waist, effectively folding down the chest section.

## OPERATING (USAGE) GUIDELINES

## 1. General Use

These waders are designed for activities in wet environments. Always exercise caution when wading in water. Be aware of currents, uneven terrain, and potential hazards. The aggressive lug outsole provides traction, but slippery conditions can still occur.

## 2. Cold Weather Use

The 800-gram Thinsulate Ultra Insulation in the boots is intended to provide warmth in cold conditions. For extreme cold, consider wearing appropriate thermal socks. The fleece-lined hand pockets offer additional warmth for your hands.

## MAINTENANCE

### 1. Cleaning

After each use, especially in muddy or saltwater environments, rinse your waders thoroughly with fresh water. This helps remove dirt, debris, and corrosive elements. Hang them to dry completely in a well-ventilated area away from direct sunlight or heat sources. Ensure the inside is also dry to prevent mildew.

The manufacturer specifies **Machine Wash** for care. Follow these guidelines:

- Use a mild detergent.
- Wash on a gentle cycle with cold water.
- Do not use bleach or fabric softeners.
- Tumble dry on low heat or hang dry. Avoid high heat, which can damage the waterproof membrane.

## 2. Storage

Store waders in a cool, dry place. Avoid folding them tightly for extended periods, as this can create creases that may lead to material fatigue. Hanging them is ideal to maintain their shape and integrity.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### 1. Leaks

If you suspect a leak:

- **Pinholes:** Fill the waders with water (or turn them inside out and spray with rubbing alcohol) and look for dark spots or drips. Mark the area.
- **Seams:** Inspect seams for any separation or damage.
- **Repair:** Small leaks can often be repaired using a wader repair kit, typically involving a waterproof sealant or patch. Follow the repair kit's instructions carefully.

### 2. Condensation/Dampness Inside

Even with breathable fabric, condensation can occur, especially during strenuous activity or in humid conditions. This is not necessarily a leak. Ensure you are wearing appropriate layering underneath to wick away moisture from your skin. If dampness persists and you suspect a leak, refer to the 'Leaks' section above.

### 3. Odor

If waders develop an odor, it is often due to improper drying. Ensure they are thoroughly dried inside and out after each use. A mild disinfectant spray designed for outdoor gear can help neutralize odors, but always test on an inconspicuous area first.
