1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Keter 60/5 Shelf Unit is a versatile and durable storage solution designed for organizing various indoor spaces such as garages, laundry rooms, and utility areas. Constructed from robust plastic, this unit features five shelves, each capable of holding a significant amount of weight, providing efficient and compact storage.

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Keter shelf unit.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembling or using the shelf unit. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Wall Mounting:** For maximum stability and safety, it is mandatory to fix the shelf unit to a wall using appropriate fasteners (not included). This prevents tipping, especially when shelves are loaded.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 20 kg (44 lbs) per shelf. Distribute weight evenly across each shelf. Overloading can cause structural failure.

- **Assembly:** Assemble the unit on a flat, stable surface. Ensure all components are securely connected before use.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the unit during assembly. Do not allow children to climb on or play with the shelf unit.
- **Placement:** Place the shelf unit on a level surface. Avoid placing it in areas with high humidity or direct sunlight for prolonged periods, as this may affect material integrity over time.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- A. Shelf Panels:** (5 pieces per unit) – Flat plastic panels forming the storage surfaces.
- B. Vertical Support Posts:** (16 pieces per unit) – Connect the shelf panels vertically.
- C. Feet/Base Caps:** (4 pieces per unit) – Provide stability at the bottom of the unit.
- D. Wall Mounting Brackets:** (2 pieces per unit) – For securing the unit to a wall. (Fasteners not included)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is straightforward and does not require special tools. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Prepare the Area:** Clear a flat, clean, and spacious area for assembly.
2. **Assemble the Base:** Take one shelf panel (A) and attach four vertical support posts (B) into the designated holes on its underside. Ensure they click securely into place.
3. **Add Feet:** Insert the four feet/base caps (C) into the bottom ends of the vertical support posts attached to the base shelf.
4. **Stack Shelves:** Place the next shelf panel (A) onto the top ends of the four vertical support posts. Press down firmly until it locks into position. Repeat this step for the remaining three shelf panels, ensuring each is securely seated.
5. **Complete Top:** Once all five shelves are stacked, the unit should be stable.
6. **Wall Mounting (Crucial):** Position the assembled shelf unit against the desired wall. Using the wall mounting brackets (D), mark the drilling points on the wall. Drill appropriate holes and secure the brackets to the wall.

and the shelf unit using suitable screws and wall anchors (not supplied). This step is essential for preventing the unit from tipping over, especially when loaded.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled and securely wall-mounted, your Keter shelf unit is ready for use.

- **Loading Items:** Place items on the shelves, distributing weight as evenly as possible.
- **Weight Limit:** Each shelf has a maximum load capacity of 20 kg (44 lbs). Do not exceed this limit. Refer to Image 5.1 for a visual representation of the weight capacity.
- **Stability:** Always ensure the unit remains stable. If you notice any wobbling or instability, re-check the wall mounting and ensure items are distributed correctly.

6. MAINTENANCE

The Keter shelf unit requires minimal maintenance to ensure its longevity and appearance.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the unit with a damp cloth and mild soap solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the plastic.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all connections and wall mounting points to ensure they remain secure. Tighten any loose fasteners if necessary.
- **Storage:** If disassembling for storage, ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Shelf unit is wobbly or unstable.	Not properly wall-mounted; uneven floor; connections not secure.	Ensure the unit is securely fixed to the wall. Move to a level surface or use shims under the feet. Check all shelf and post connections are fully engaged.
Shelves are sagging.	Overloaded shelf; weight not evenly distributed.	Reduce the weight on the shelf, ensuring it does not exceed 20 kg. Redistribute items to balance the load.
Parts do not fit during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; debris in connection points.	Verify that parts are oriented correctly according to the instructions. Check for and remove any debris from the connection points. Apply firm, even pressure during assembly.
