Vortex H35 Cordless Vacuum Turbo Brush Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the turbo brush is securely attached, you can begin cleaning. The integrated motor and soft rollers are designed for efficient and safe cleaning.

- **Power On:** Turn on your Vortex H35 vacuum cleaner. The turbo brush will activate automatically.
- **Maneuvering:** Utilize the wide 90° angular movement of the brush head to easily navigate around furniture and into tight spaces.
- **Floor Types:** The extra-soft brush and rollers are suitable for various floor types, including delicate surfaces, without causing damage.
- **Optimal Performance:** For best results, move the vacuum cleaner at a steady pace, allowing the turbo brush to effectively agitate and lift dirt.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your turbo brush.

1. **Brush Roller Cleaning:**
 - Ensure the vacuum is off and unplugged.
 - Detach the turbo brush from the vacuum.
 - Locate the release mechanism for the brush roller (refer to your main Vortex H35 vacuum manual if needed for specific instructions on accessory disassembly).
 - Remove the brush roller.
 - Carefully remove any tangled hair, threads, or debris from the brush roller using scissors or a brush cleaning tool.
 - Wipe the roller and its housing with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembly.
2. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the turbo brush with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
3. **Storage:** Store the turbo brush in a clean, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Reduced cleaning performance | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Brush roller dirty or worn• Vacuum filter clogged | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean or replace the brush roller.• Clean or replace the vacuum's filter (refer to your main Vortex H35 vacuum manual). |
| Unusual noise from brush | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foreign object lodged in brush• Worn bearings | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Turn off and detach the brush, inspect for and remove any foreign objects.• If noise persists after cleaning, contact customer support. |



