Brakes feel loose or ineffective.	Brake cable needs adjustment; brake pads worn.	Adjust brake cables; inspect and replace brake pads if necessary. Consult a technician if unsure.
Unusual noises during operation.	Loose components; motor issue; suspension issue.	Inspect for loose parts and tighten; if noise persists, contact customer support.
