1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the LEHMANN XXL 8L Air Fryer. This appliance is designed to cook your favorite foods with little to no oil, providing a healthier alternative to traditional frying methods. Please read this instruction manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation. Keep this manual for future reference.

Important Safety Instructions

- · Read all instructions before use.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- · Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls or other appliances to allow proper air circulation.

2. Product Overview and Components

The LEHMANN XXL 8L Air Fryer consists of several key components designed for efficient and convenient cooking.

Components:

- 1. Main Unit: Houses the heating element, fan, and control panel.
- 2. Control Panel: LED touch screen for setting time, temperature, and selecting programs.
- 3. Cooking Basket: Removable, non-stick basket for holding food during cooking.
- 4. Crisper Plate: Sits inside the cooking basket, allowing air to circulate around food for even cooking and crisping.
- 5. **Handle:** Ergonomic handle for safely removing and inserting the cooking basket.
- 6. Air Outlet Vent: Located at the rear of the appliance for hot air exhaust.
- 7. **Power Cord:** For connecting the appliance to an electrical outlet.

3. Setup

Before First Use:

- 1. **Unpack:** Remove all packaging materials, stickers, and labels from the appliance.
- 2. **Clean Components:** Wash the cooking basket and crisper plate thoroughly with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse and dry completely. The main unit can be wiped with a damp cloth.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is at least 10 cm (4 inches) of clear space around the back and sides of the appliance to allow for proper air circulation. Do not place it directly under cabinets.
- 4. **Initial Run (Optional):** To eliminate any manufacturing odors, you may run the air fryer empty for about 10-15 minutes at 180°C (350°F). Ensure the area is well-ventilated during this process.

4. Operating Instructions

The LEHMANN Air Fryer features an intuitive LED touch screen for easy operation.

Control Panel Overview:

- Power Button: Turns the appliance on/off.
- Temperature/Time Controls (+/-): Adjusts cooking temperature and time.
- Preheat: Activates the preheating function.
- Start/Pause: Begins or pauses the cooking cycle.
- Stop/Cancel: Stops the current cooking program.
- Turn Reminder: Activates a reminder to shake or turn food during cooking.
- Preset Program Icons: Select from 12 optimized cooking programs.

Using Preset Programs:

The air fryer comes with 12 pre-programmed settings for common dishes. These settings automatically adjust temperature and time for optimal results.

- 1. Place food in the cooking basket, ensuring the crisper plate is inserted. Do not overfill.
- 2. Insert the cooking basket back into the main unit.
- 3. Press the Power button to turn on the display.
- 4. Select the desired preset program by tapping its icon on the touch screen. The display will show the default temperature and time for that program.
- 5. You can adjust the default temperature and time using the +/- buttons if needed.
- 6. Press the Start button to begin cooking.
- 7. Some programs may include a 'Turn Reminder' halfway through cooking. The appliance will beep, and the 'Turn Reminder' icon will flash. Carefully remove the basket, shake or turn the food, and reinsert the basket to resume cooking.
- 8. Once cooking is complete, the air fryer will beep. Carefully remove the basket and transfer food to a serving dish.

Manual Operation:

For custom recipes or specific cooking needs, you can manually set the temperature and time.

1. Place food in the cooking basket and insert it into the main unit.

- 2. Press the Power button.
- 3. Use the 'Temp' +/- buttons to set the desired temperature (range: 76-200°C).
- 4. Use the 'Time' +/- buttons to set the desired cooking time.
- 5. Press the Start button to begin cooking.

Preheating Function:

Preheating can improve cooking results for certain foods.

- 1. Press the Power button.
- 2. Press the 'Preheat' button. The display will show a default preheat temperature and time.
- 3. Adjust temperature and time if necessary using the +/- buttons.
- 4. Press Start. The air fryer will preheat. Once complete, it will beep, and you can then add your food and start the cooking cycle.

5. Cleaning and Maintenance

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your air fryer.

Cleaning the Cooking Basket and Crisper Plate:

- Always unplug the air fryer and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- The cooking basket and crisper plate are dishwasher safe. Alternatively, they can be washed by hand with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge.
- For stubborn food residue, soak the basket and plate in warm, soapy water for about 10-15 minutes before cleaning.
- · Avoid using metal utensils or abrasive cleaning materials on the non-stick coating, as this can damage the surface.

Cleaning the Main Unit:

- Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Clean the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth and mild detergent if necessary. Ensure no water enters the heating element area.
- Never immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.

Storage:

Ensure the air fryer is clean and completely dry before storing. Store it in a cool, dry place.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your air fryer, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---------------------------------------|---|--|
| Air fryer does not turn on. | Appliance is not plugged in. Power outlet is not working. | Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check the circuit breaker. |
| Food is not cooked evenly. | Basket is overcrowded. Food pieces are too large. Food was not shaken/turned. | Cook food in smaller batches. Cut food into smaller, more uniform pieces. Shake or turn food halfway through cooking. |
| White smoke comes from the appliance. | Grease residue from previous use. Fatty food being cooked. | Clean the basket and crisper plate thoroughly after each use. Remove excess fat from food before cooking. |
| Food is not crispy. | Not enough oil (if applicable). Temperature too low or time too short. | Lightly coat food with oil for extra crispiness. Increase temperature or cooking time. Ensure crisper plate is in place. |
